



#### LENT AND EASTER GUIDELINES

THE LENTEN SEASON A distinction is to be made between Lent and the Easter Triduum. Strictly speaking, Lent ends with the beginning of the Triduum on Holy Thursday. The Ordo notes: "Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday."

#### FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

**Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Abstinence** from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance.



After a prayer for the healing of body, soul and spirit for ourselves and our loved ones, each person receives a small folder of suggestions for healing the earth & uplifting the poor in Christ's name.

**THE WAY FORWARD** – By doing what Jesus asks us to in memory of him we draw refreshment from the stream of live-giving waters as we face the challenge of spreading the joy of the gospel in a world of confusion and conflict. MASS is celebrated at the climax of the mission. At Communion, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for an optional holy hour.

**RADIANT SPLENDOR** – The day of the first creation is passing into the day of the new creation. We ponder the wonder of it all as we experience the hope and feel the energy to be good stewards of the earth and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The service is preceded by an optional holy hour and is conducted in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Benediction and the announcement of the plenary indulgence conclude the mission.
