



With so much uncertainty regarding the COVID-19 virus and increasing recommendations to avoid crowds and take proper safety precautions, we wanted to remind you that we have options in place now that you can use today. April 27, 2020, Update from Archbishop Aymond

The governor extended the "stay home" mandate until May 15, 2020.

Because "Church" is an <u>essential</u> part of our lives – effective immediately, public Mass can be celebrated <u>but only 10 people</u> may attend each Mass.

The following <u>directives</u> are to be implemented for each Mass:

- 1. The people of the Archdiocese are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass.
- 2. If someone is vulnerable and not feeling well, they should not celebrate Mass in church with other people.
- 3. Attendance at Mass: The number of people who can gather in the church is <u>not to exceed 10 people</u>. This applies also to Baptisms, Weddings and funerals. This number will increase gradually.
- 4. For those who feel obliged to fulfill the Sunday obligation, a weekday Mass could accomplish this.
- 5. Additional Vigil Masses, Sunday and weekday Masses may be added to accommodate more people.
- 6. Either by computer, or by phone, people could make reservations to attend a specific Mass. More information on this soon.
- 7. An usher must make certain the 10-person rule is observed.
- 8. A specific Mass could be designated for the elderly who are in good health.
- 9. The church should be sanitized after each service.
- 10. Family members may sit in the same pew.
- 11. Social distancing must be observed 6 feet apart. (This may necessitate roping off pews or putting markers for people to sit.) Six feet apart applies to the communion line as well.
- 12. Make sure all ministers observe proper hygiene of their hands.
- 13. Regarding the celebration of Mass:
- a. Ministers and parishioners should wear a mask.
- b. The priest/deacons should wear a mask at communion.
- c. Give communion with no bodily contact. Gently let the host touch the person's hand and drop it in their hand without touching them.
- d. Communion on the tongue is not encouraged.
- e. The chalice with the precious blood is not to be offered.
- f. The sign of peace can be given by bowing to the other person.
- g. As people depart from Mass, social distancing must be observed.

The number who may attend will increase gradually, but in the meantime, we want to cooperate, so the virus does not spread.

I am doing Masses as follows: Sunday 8am, 10am, and 11:30am; Monday 12pm; Tuesday 12pm and 4pm; Wednesday 12pm; Thursday 12pm; Friday 12pm; & Saturday 8am and 4pm. You are invited to celebrate with us. **Remember to please practice proper hygiene with handwashing and masking along with physical distancing**. Looking forward to seeing you at mass. Also, due to pastoral necessity, if I need to add masses, I can. If the number of attendees begins to exceed comfortable levels, I can celebrate more masses so that more people can attend.
