



ST. JOSEPH & ST. ANTHONY OPEN FOR BUSINESS I.E. MASSES

Effective May 16, public Mass can be celebrated in church using 25% of the occupancy of the church.

For St. Joseph 100 people and St. Anthony 200 people.

Please follow the guidelines listed below:

- 1. The people of the Archdiocese are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. If you are uncomfortable attending Mass, continue to watch it at home.
- 2. If someone is vulnerable and not feeling well, they should not celebrate Mass in church with other people.
- 3. Attendance at Mass: The number of people who can gather in the church is 25% of the occupancy of the church. This applies also to Baptisms, Weddings, funerals and receiving candidates who are to enter the church. This number will increase gradually.
- 4. First Communion can be celebrated with 25% occupancy on Sunday or a weekday.
- 5. For those who feel obliged to fulfill the Sunday obligation, a weekday Mass could accomplish this.
- 6. Additional Vigil Masses may be added to accommodate more people depending on turn-out.
- 7. The Four o'clock Vigil Mass at St. Joseph tends to be the mass the elderly who are in good health attend. Please give preference to them.
- 8. Family members may sit in the same pew.
- 9. Social distancing must be observed -6 feet apart. Six feet apart applies to the communion line as well.
- 10. Holy water fonts will remain empty. Holy Water for home use is in the reservoir.

- 11. Please observe proper hygiene of your hands.
- 12. All are encouraged to wear a mask for Mass.
- 13. Communion will be given with no bodily contact. The Host will be gently dropped into the hand without touching the person. Communion on the tongue is not encouraged but permitted. The chalice with the precious blood is not offered. The communal offering of the sign of peace will be omitted. As people depart from Mass, social distancing must be observed.
- 14. Hand sanitizer is offered at the entrances of Church. Please utilize this before and after Mass. Disinfectant spray will be in Church if you feel the desire to disinfect where you sit. If you are concerned about surfaces, you are welcome to bring your own sanitizer, disinfectant, or other means of keeping yourself safe. Remember: no one can clean a surface better than you.
- 15. Continue to pray!
- 16. See you all soon at Mass

Letter from the Archbishop


