



Food Pantry

Catholic Charities' food pantry is open Monday – Thursday from 10 am – 2 pm. The food pantry is located at 2505 Maine Ave in Metairie. Clients should go down the driveway to the left of the

building. The food pantry is located in the back building, fourth door from the front. Clients can receive a prepacked bag of food and some optional supplemental items every two weeks. Clients fill out a simple intake form at their first visit, and at subsequent visits only need provide their name. Please wear a mask and respect social distancing when receiving assistance.

NEW MASS GUIDELINES

Since we are now under Phase 2 of the reopening guidelines, churches are open again officially for public masses. St. Joseph and St. Anthony churches have returned to our regular mass schedules. This means that the number of people gathered in Church can be 50% of the occupancy (200 for St Joseph and 400 for St. Anthony), but must take into account the 6 feet social distancing. If social distancing cannot be maintained, then less than 50% of occupancy can gather. Please be careful observe this guideline. to This formula applies to Mass, Baptisms, Funerals, Weddings, First Communion, Confirmation and any other religious service.

Please remember to practice proper handwashing before coming to church, wear a mask/face covering and practice physical distancing. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant spray will be provided for your use as you enter church. If you are ill for any reason, please refrain from attending mass.
