St. Anthony Church

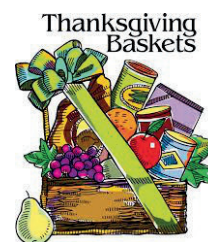

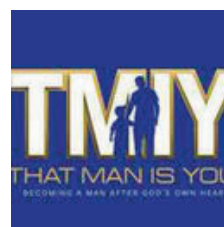


Christmas Flowers Donation

Phase III Guidelines
