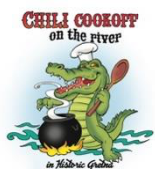
St. Joseph Rummage Sale Cancelled

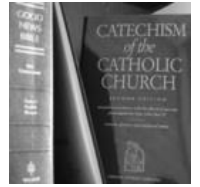
