We commend them to Your loving care because their duty is dangerous.

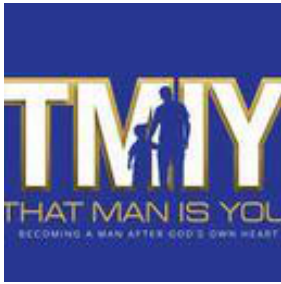
Grant them strength and courage in their daily assignments.

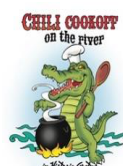


