Due to the Archdiocesan Priest Convention being held September 19-21, 2022, Communion Service will be held instead of mass – schedule is as follows:

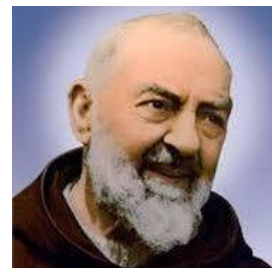
