#### **Brief Family Background**

Lawrence Wumya was born on Sunday, September 10, 1989, in Malshegu, Tamale, in the northern part of Ghana, to Mr. Charles Kobli Wumya Naporo and Regina Amina Wumya Dasana. Both parents got converted to Christianity before their marriage in 1988. I was

baptized and confirmed on April 10, 2004, at Malshegu, a mission Church community of Holy Cross Parish.

I am the first of three children of my parents. My parents were baptized and confirmed Catholics. They were both devout Catholics and committed members of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal. My father passed on May 17, 2017, two years into my seminary formation. The marriage life of my parents was one of dignity and respect, worthy of emulation. Their life together as a couple impacted and influenced my life greatly: my religious, social, and emotional worldviews have been shaped by their marriage life.

2011-2014 - Three-year Diploma in Basic Education Certificate

2014 -2015 - Part-time classroom teacher in Primary Four and taught Core-Mathematics at Senior High School

2015-2016 – Started Seminary foundation at St. Michael Propaediutic Major Seminary, Diocese of Yendi

2016-2019 - St. Paul's Catholic Seminary, Accra - three-year philosophy studies

2019-2021 – St. Peter's Reginal Seminary, Cape Coast – theology studies

Midway through 2021 – transferred to Notre Dame Seminary, New Orleans, where he continues his studies until today.

#### **Brief Vocation Story**

The Priest who has been my role model in my discernment process was Fr. Olivier Leicester, Missionary of Africa, a French man. He learned and mastered the local language, Dagbani, and was even more fluent in speech and legible in writing than the natives. As a result, he translated almost everything about the liturgy into the local language. His desire, passion, zeal, perseverance, faith, hope, and love for people is what I want to model my priesthood upon.

My desire to be a priest began when I was a senior in high school. However, out of fear of failure, I decided to suppress the desire and I proceeded to enroll in Teacher Training College. The cause of my fear was, first, based on the fact, that my community is 97% Muslim, and my family is 90% Muslim. As Muslims, they cannot even conceive the idea of marrying one wife, how could they understand a man who would not marry at all? Second, people from my community have entered the seminary before me but left somewhere through. These were the causes of my fear because I do not want to begin a journey I would not end. I never lost the desire even as a teacher. However, because of the same fear, I decided to proceed to the university. A few weeks later, I visited a village on Ash Wednesday. They told me that they had not had Mass in three months because there were no priests. They only put ashes on their own heads to remind them that it was Ash Wednesday. This experience affirmed my desire for the vocation of priesthood and gave me the courage to enter the seminary without any regrets about passing up my university admission.




