## **Friendship**

In the second reading today, St. Paul spoke about the end of time, when the second coming of Jesus would signal an end of life on earth as we know it. He was given a teaching mission by Jesus to enlighten all people about the love and forgiveness of God the Father.

I once read something that the teacher can only teach what the students want to learn. St. Paul's students were the Jews, who had power and control which they did not want to give up and the Gentiles who had very few spiritual principles to live by and did not want to change. It would be like our first class of Algebra or the first time we were given a class on how to read sheet music. St. Paul did not give up, and was very successful, even though the reward for his efforts was to be put to death in Rome for his efforts.

In next week's second reading St. Paul is speaking to the Corinthians about anxiety, and how the things in our daily life can lead us away from the importance of the true reason for our existence. St. Paul reflects on how our everyday lives can distract us from the teachings of Jesus. Our relationships with each other and our use of things of this world are meant to lead us to everlasting life with our creator. People were created to be loved; things were created to be used. True peace can only be had by focusing on the hereafter not on the here and now.


