



### LENT AND EASTER GUIDELINES

THE LENTEN SEASON A distinction is to be made between Lent and the Easter Triduum. Strictly speaking, Lent ends with the beginning of the Triduum on Holy Thursday. The Ordo notes: "Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday."

### **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE**

**Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Abstinence** from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance.

### Friendship

Anxiety is something that we have learned to live with. Our everyday lives deal with different choices that could affect our health, our livelihood, and our families. We spend time worrying if what we are doing is best for us and our loved ones. St. Paul said in the second reading today that there is only one way to make the right decision and that is to think about the reason that we are here and where we are going rather than what we have and how we will use it. People were created to be loved and things were created to be used. Sometimes we allow our hearts to become overwhelmed with the love of things and sooner or later we will fall into the use of people to protect the things we love.

Next Sunday we will hear Paul speaking to the people of Corinth about his transformation from being a persecutor of Christ to becoming a voice of Jesus mercy. St. Paul was preaching the Gospel as a mission which was given to him as a gift. He was to spread the words of Jesus, so that all would hear the message and Paul would receive nothing in return except the knowledge of the importance of the mission and the power of the word. St. Paul's journey was difficult most of the time because he was challenging the message of people who were in power and the way many people chose to live without spiritual direction. St. Paul looked at his reward as being chosen to do this and the good he could do by spreading the word of Jesus.


