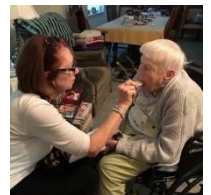

Friendship

Today in the second reading we hear from St. John. He was one of the apostles and the only one that was not put to death. He was also the one that Jesus gave the responsibility for and of care for Mary his mother.

St. John lived many years after the death of Jesus and was the author of the fourth book of the gospel. He also wrote and inspired letters for the followers of Jesus. His letters covered a time about three generations after Christ's resurrection.

Times were different then and some of the people were converting to the teaching of Christianity while others were not so much opposing it but trying to improve it. They were Greek and their belief was not one of acceptance but one of compromise. The Greeks wanted it to become part of a secular philosophy which regarded the body as being evil and the spirit was all that mattered.

St. John wrote that Jesus was born out of the love of the Father, and we should love each other with the same love that God has for us. We were born to love, and we should also be loved. True love will bring us to the point that St. John made in his description of love. He wrote in 7 words, "Obedience is the only proof of love." I have always defined love as an act and a commitment. I believe that obedience is part of both the act and the commitment.

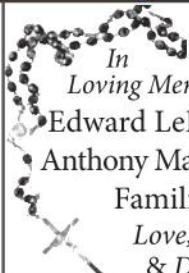
