



The CYO Young Adult Ministry is planning to host a "Theology on Tap" for young adults with the Perpetual Pilgrims on Sunday evening June 8th. This event will give the pilgrims a chance to meet our young adults and encourage them in their walk of faith. The time and place of this event are forthcoming and will be announced in the E-Bulletin and on the Young Adult Ministry Social Media channels.

The Archbishop will offer the 9:00am Mass on Sunday, June 9th at St. Lous Cathedral followed by a Eucharistic Procession around Jackson Square.
