





#### **Friendship**

St. Paul writes about a difficult situation, but he shows how the Spirit that the Jews were so bitter about will help in Paul's quest to continue to spread the word of Christ. The Jewish leadership had labeled the acknowledgement or worship of Christ and the Holy Spirit as unlawful. They went so far as to excommunicate those who spoke of it and possibly put to death anyone who proclaimed loyalty to Christ. Paul uses the presence of the Holy Spirit to bring faith to his followers. He says that the presence of the Holy Spirit is a positive proof that Jesus is God.

The Holy Spirit is a gift from God that brings witness to the truth. The truth is based on faith and that is also one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

With the gift of faith comes the gifts of love, patience, forgiveness, respect, and the knowledge of God's will.

Faith gives us the ability to see the invisible, believe the incredible and receive the impossible. The thing about faith which can help at the times in our lives which are the most difficult is that true faith overcomes fear.


