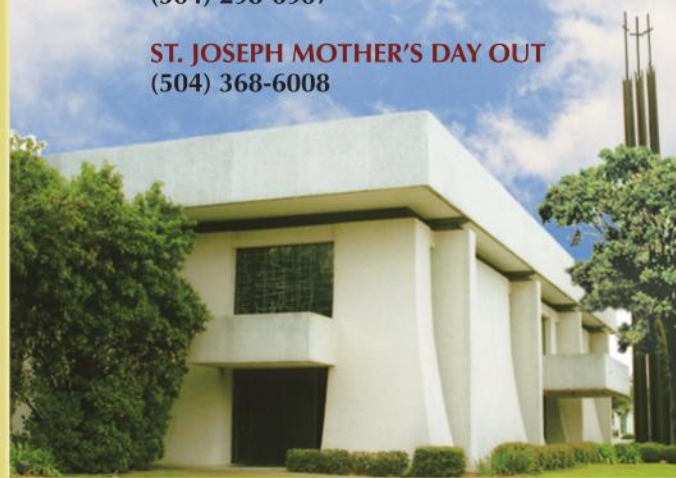

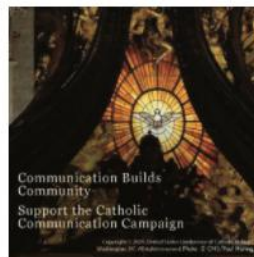

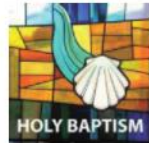

**What do your eyes see?**

Normally when we see something that gets our attention, we automatically either wish we had it or confirm that we would never have something like that. I have always wanted a red sports car but realized that it would not work for me.

We can make the same mistake when we judge people, from their appearance we might want to make friends with them or because of their appearance. We know that we would not have anything in common with them.

In the second reading today, John is speaking about the same thing. He was wanting the love and faith of the people, not what they looked like, to become the foundation of the church that he was building for Jesus. Today the same can be true. We as Catholics must not focus on what someone's appearance but what is in their hearts. Our faith can only grow by opening our minds and hearts to not only what the media and society has condoned but to what our faith in them can accomplish. We cannot give up on this commitment to Jesus, not to strangers, friends, and most of all to our loved ones.

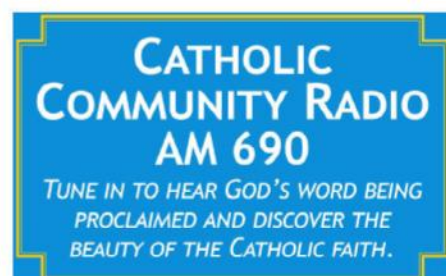

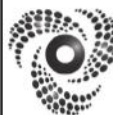
