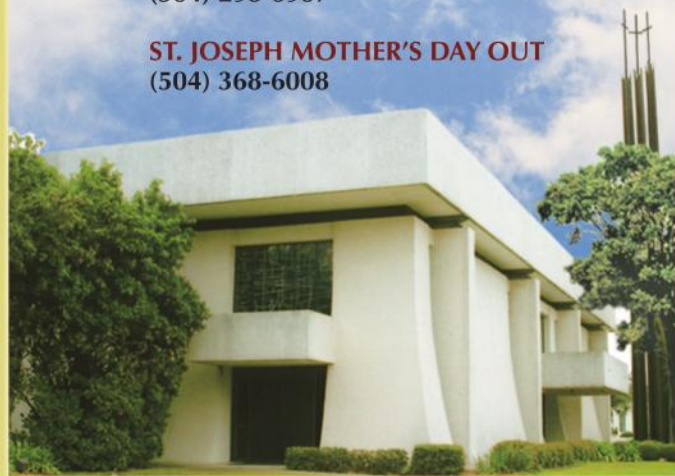

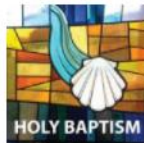

Items for the Holiday Season!!**

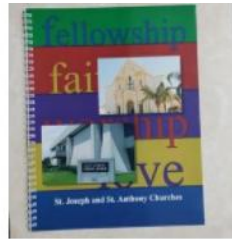

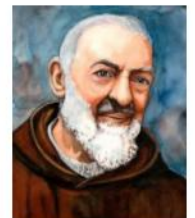

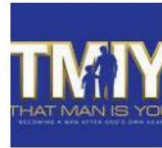

**“What does Jesus look like to you?”**

If you communicate with someone and you cannot see them it helps if you have a picture of them in your mind. At times when you are speaking on the telephone you picture the other party and even if you have not met him or her you paint a picture of what you think they might look like. It follows then that you should have a picture of Jesus in your mind when you pray. People relate interesting pictures of Jesus when asked that question. Some say that they see Jesus on the cross. Some say that they see him with children. Others say they see him laughing. Still others say they see him as the risen Christ. Now I would like all of you to close your eyes, just for a few seconds, and visualize “your” Jesus.

I believe that the picture you choose of Jesus will reflect the qualities you most admire in him and want to imitate in your actions. Now think about it. If you see him with children, your image of Jesus might lead you to teach or protect our young. If you see him on the cross, you see the pain he bore and when you have pain you can offer it up to him. If you see him laughing it should bring joy to your day. Most importantly if your image of Jesus changes that simply means that you are changing the part of him you wish to imitate.
