



#### NAME versus FAME

Some time ago a wise man told me that he would rather be remembered for what he has accomplished rather than who he was. When I asked why, he said "What one's title is of no account, but what one does in one's life is of supreme importance."

Shifting to the readings for today the fig tree in Luke's Gospel was symbolic of a person who has perfected the science of putting things off. I don't know what the conversion factor from a human's life is to a tree's life in years, but 3 years seems like a long time without bearing fruit. You see the soil was very shallow and lacked the minerals that affected growth in that part of Galilee. To keep this tree would have depleted the soil of the resources that were important for the other fruit bearing trees. This is why the owner wanted it removed. The gardener saw things differently. He was a caring person that was more knowledgeable about the growing process and asked for a little more time and to give the tree another chance.

As Catholics we sometimes need a little more time to grow and another chance. I mentioned that the fig tree was a symbol of us but who is the gardener? Yes, it was Jesus, He came to cultivate us and to give us the tools to bear fruit. The tools that he gave us were the sacraments, and one of the most important ones in this Lenten season is reconciliation. Lent is the time to look at our lives, spread our branches, shed the old leaves, and grow new ones, ones that will bring us closer to God. Already we are in the third week of Lent and Easter is at the end of this month. Have we used this time to draw closer to Jesus? Have we gone to confession? Have we purged ourselves of the things that separate us from God and others. I was speaking to someone the other day and they told me that they did not go to confession because they had no sins to confess. I can see how someone would think that way, but we have to look a little further into ourselves to see what God sees.

Usually, we surround ourselves with family and loved ones, but Jesus asked us to love everybody. Please remember, charity deals with the need and not with the cause, so it is up to us to try\_to care for those who are unable to care for themselves. Here is another for instance. Occasionally we overlook the small things that we do …like when we are trying to get off the interstate and are patiently awaiting our turn in line and someone pulls in front of us. My normal reaction would be to call that person a sack full of dirty names and be upset for a while. The reason for that is that I have not resolved some of the anger I carry. The language that I use is not good, but the real problem is my reaction.


