

Pray As a Family

This is something that you could combine with dinner or right after. Make a list of important prayer topics. Maybe world events, or maybe something requiring prayer right in your community, or special prayers for family members and friends. Get the children to suggest what they feel needs prayer.

What did He write?

When I first read this Gospel, I saw a connection between it and the parable of The Prodigal Son. Both have three main characters, each a symbol of God, a stern judgmental person, and a wayward entity. Both parables bring out the properties of forgiveness, mercy, and judgement. And at the end the end both had two winners and one loser.

In today's reading the Pharisees, the legal experts, made their decision without compassion and without concern for the woman. Their only interest was to condemn her. The Pharisees looked at her as an object with which they tried to trick Jesus. Jesus on the other hand saw her as a person who deserved a second chance. We also sometimes judge people by what they do, and we overlook the reason for their action. On occasion we form our judgement of them and forget that at a different time and place we had the same weaknesses and maybe did the same thing.

Our judgement should not be based on what we see because we can only see the action of a person.

God is truly the only one capable to judge us because he is good all of the time and can see into the heart of the person. He can also see the true motivation of the action. The Pharisees were trying to trap Jesus with this woman who was caught in sin.

If he would have approved their decision to stone the woman, it would have weakened his message of love and mercy that he was preaching and eventually the reason he was crucified.

If he would have stopped it, which he did, he would have then been going against Moses' law about adultery, and this could have appeared that he was condoning that action. Jesus knew this and still outsmarted his adversaries.

Whenever the parable is discussed the first question that arises is what did Jesus write in the sand? There are a number of theories about this one being that he was taking his time to pray for the answer. Another one was he could not face the anger in the eyes of the accusers. No one really knows but the turning point was the statement he made about the one who is without sin was to throw the first stone. After the smoke cleared and everyone except the woman went home Jesus asked, "Has no one condemn you?" She replied, "No one sir." He said, "Neither do I condemn you. Go and from now on do not sin anymore."

Jesus showed forgiveness and mercy, but he did add, "And from now on do not sin anymore."

What do you think that Jesus is telling us?
