

The Passion of our Lord

The story of the Passion of Our Lord began with the fall of Adam and Eve in the Garden when they wanted to ascend from their human nature to the nature of God. In today's Gospel, which took place many years later, we read about the "New Adam," when Jesus chose to take on a human nature along with his Divine nature. Jesus, who is God, chose to be like man so that he could reverse the damage that our first parents did to their relationship with the Father. Even in this reversal some aspects of this transformation are very similar. Because of their decision, Adam and Eve were detached from the favor of God and had to go on pretty much on their own. The more that we look at it the more it appears that Jesus' choice to become man and suffer and die for our sins caused a brief separation in his communication with his father. I mention that because the passion of Christ would have meant very little if he had undergone the suffering as God and distanced himself from the qualities of the human nature that he came to rescue. Therefore, Jesus, the son of the Father, went through the passion in his human nature, feeling all of the agony, scourging, crowning, and crucifixion that we would feel if we were to have the same fate.

But I believe that for him the worst of the suffering was the detachment from the Father.

When Jesus accepted the sins of humanity in his passion these sins hindered his relationship with his father as we are inhibited in our relationship with God when we sin. For a moment think about how lonely he was. He prayed constantly throughout the day, and whenever he needed help, he asked the advice of his Father.

To put that in perspective think about someone with whom you communicate daily and depend upon, all of a sudden you are cut off from that source of direction, comfort, and peace. Most of us have lost a loved one, a person who was dear to us. Remember the quiet, the stillness, the sadness. Jesus gave up that contact and endured the suffering, the pain, and the humiliation of the death of a criminal in order to reestablish the communication with his Father that Adam and Eve deprived us of.

This week is Holy Week, a week when there are many services here at St. Joseph to give us the chance to utilize that communication link to Jesus and to his Father. Please join us as much as you can to celebrate our redemption purchased for us by the love and suffering of Jesus Christ.
