

Mercy and Forgiveness

I want you to think about a time in your life when you knew that you were right about something and all of a sudden you started to doubt yourself. Then you spoke with someone with great enthusiasm, but he started to be little you and became hostile. So, you backed off and accepted his ridicule and for the next couple of days you were depressed, angry and lonely. Then on the very next day you found out that you were right all along, and your position was correct, and you were on the top of the world again. Now on a beach, Peter was going to have to face Jesus and tell him that although he had promised Him that he would never betray Him he denied Him three times. I think all of us have had faith in something and for some reason doubted ourselves. Jesus knew that Peter, our first Pope, was going to lose faith and He forgave him. Jesus also knows that at times we are going to doubt, and He will forgive us also. All we need to do is trust in Jesus' mercy and forgiveness. This is part of a prayer that I say, "Merciless is the judgment on the man who has not shown mercy: but mercy triumphs over judgment." Jesus will judge us as we judge others. I believe that this is the core message of today's Gospel. It must have been a confusing time for the apostles and all that loved Jesus. They thought that they were on the winning team and all of a sudden their leader; their coach was led off and crucified. What were they going to do? Where were they going to go? Would they be killed like Jesus?

Then Jesus is back with them. He rose from the dead and never gave up His human nature which He proved by eating the fish that He had prepared. He was no ghost or hallucination. Jesus' human nature remained along with His divine nature. He was teaching them again and when He went back to live with His father, He was going to send the Holy Spirit to remain with them and us until the end of the earth.

Merciless is the judgment on the man who has not shown mercy: but mercy triumphs over judgment. The Our Father also says, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who have trespassed against us."

Mercy and forgiveness, two concepts which are difficult to do but essential for us to accomplish God's will and for Him to give to us.

Mercy is compassion shown to an offender. Forgiveness is to give up resentment to allow room for error. Both are positive actions which put us back in control of our lives.

I was speaking to someone the other day about forgiveness, and they told me it was necessary to forgive

someone who injured you because if you did not you would give them free rent to run around in your head. Jesus showed us the meaning of the two virtues when he forgave the soldiers at the very minute that they were nailing His flesh to the cross.

Soon you will be attending Mass and will be called to the altar to receive the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Please use those minutes to forgive anyone who is running around in your head rent free. And have mercy on the ones who have injured you and show them compassion for their offence to you. It is part of our journey that will grant you the mercy and forgiveness of God.


