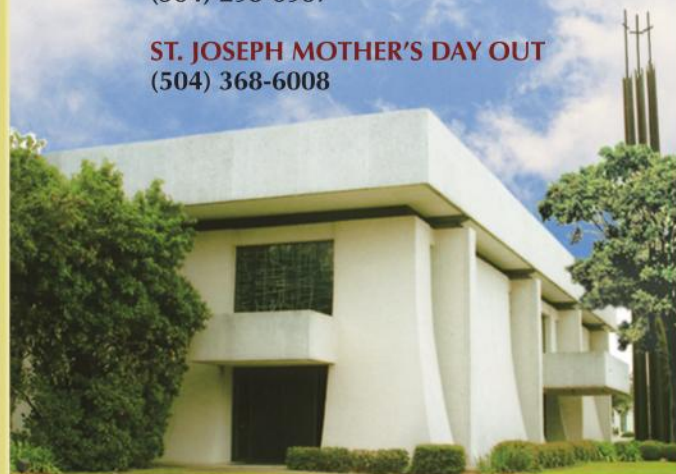

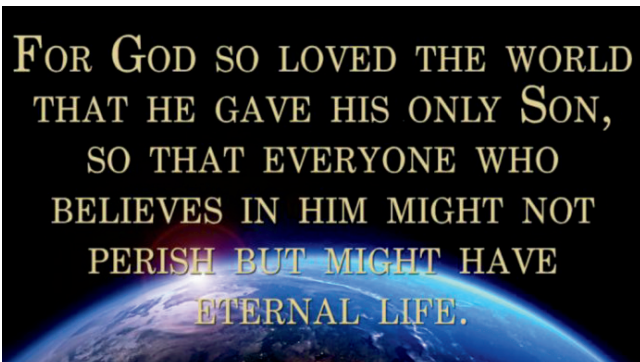

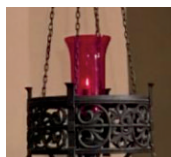

It did not happen to me or not that I remember.

A young father, rather new at it, spent the entire dinner correcting his young son's table manners and finally turned to his wife and said in distress, "Will the training never end?" To which his wife responded "A boys training never ends, he just marries, and his wife gets the job. And please stop talking with food in your mouth." Gentlemen need I say more. Community – the love and caring of each other,

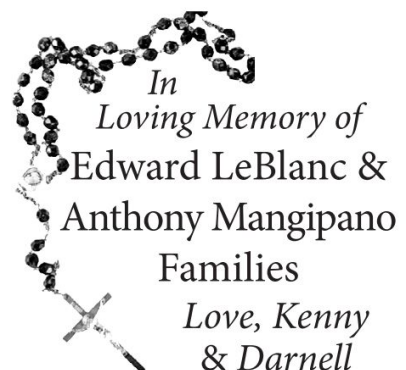
Theology – the study of God through scripture and the Catholic Faith,
