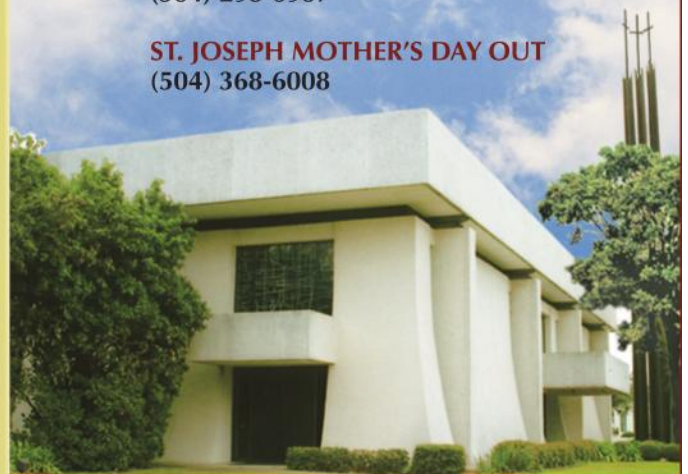

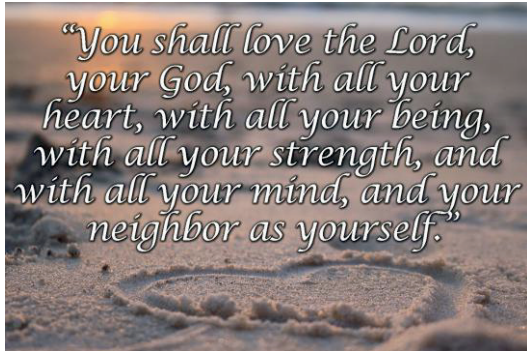

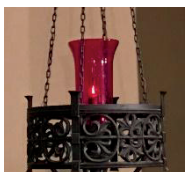

St. Joseph is in need of
Extraordinary Ministers of
Holy Communion and
Readers at our weekend
Masses. Training is
available to prepare one for
this ministry. In the Catholic

Mass, the role of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy
Communion (EMOHCs) is a vital ministry that ensures
the reverent and orderly distribution of the Eucharist.
This ministry is not merely a functional role, but a
profound act of service and devotion, reflecting the deep
reverence for the Body and Blood of Christ.
Understanding the responsibilities and significance of
EMOHCs can deepen our appreciation for this ministry
and inspire those called to serve.

The Purpose and Need for Extraordinary Ministers to
assist in the distribution of Holy Communion when
there are not enough ordained ministers (bishops, priests
and deacons) to serve the congregation. This need often
arises in parishes with large congregations or during
special liturgical celebrations where the number of
communicants is particularly high. The term
“extraordinary” highlights that this role is
supplementary and not a replacement for the ordinary
ministers of Holy Communion. Please contact Fr. Gary

Who is my neighbor?

One of the themes that came from today's reading was the
point of being a good neighbor. Now how is that to be
defined? Should it be a geographic location or a spiritual
awareness? Jesus' concept was that of the latter.

In today Luke's Gospel reading the priest and Levite had
more important things to do then help the poor traveler
because if they would have shown love to the traveler there
would have been consequences involved. When we love
someone and put their wellbeing before our own there can be
a risk. When you act with courage there can be a danger, but
it also could be something that needs to be done.

Now, who is our neighbor? Is it someone who is like us, in
education, religion, culture, our position? Someone who went
to school with us or belongs to our church or lets us borrow
anything they have. If this is correct it would be easy to love
our neighbor. Jesus' view of our neighbor is not only the
people like us but all people. Our neighbors are everyone,
especially those who are in need. If you think about it, that is
the only way it can be because if not then they would not be
our neighbors and they would not have to love us. Once again
it comes down to putting God's will before our will. Jesus
gave these words to St. Luke to pass on to us so that we can
live with the love of our neighbor. Just think about this. When
we get to heaven we will all be neighbors and now would be
a good time to adjust to that reality. If not, we would have to
spend some time in, “**Do Better School.**”
