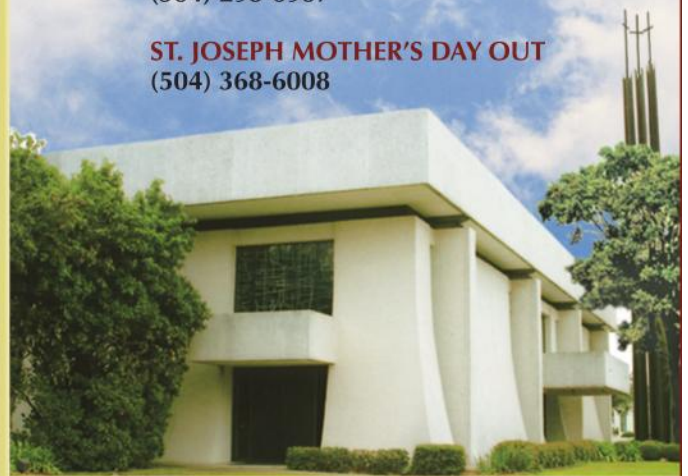

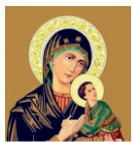

**Fr. Mansuetus Setonga from the Diocese  
of Same in the Kilimanjaro Region of  
Tanzania will be visiting our parish  
(July 26-27) to make a mission appeal for**

critical needs in his Diocese. Tanzania is one of the poorest countries in the world, with 80% of the population practicing rural subsistence farming. Tanzania has a population of 57 million people, 15 million of whom live in absolute poverty, earning less than \$1.00 a day. The standard of living of the people in the Diocese of Same is below that of most Tanzanians. Catholics number 74,104.

One of the serious problems facing the people of Same is poor health which is caused by dirty water. In Bangalala village, women walk on foot for more than four miles back and forth to reach a standing dam/rain water dam. The water is shared by both villagers and cows, goats and sheep. Due to the lack of clean water many people suffer from diarrhea, typhoid, and cholera. Due to the lack of nearby clinics, many children and women die from these water-related diseases. These are all preventable diseases. The Diocese of Same has been requested by these villagers to help them to drill a well. Please prayerfully consider how you may be able to support this important mission. A second collection will be taken up for the Diocese of Same.

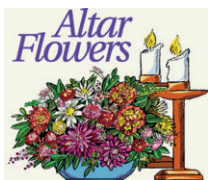

St. Joseph is in need of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Readers at our weekend Masses. Training is available to prepare one for this ministry. In the Catholic Mass, the role of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMOHCs) is a vital ministry that ensures the reverent and orderly distribution of the Eucharist. This ministry is not merely a functional role, but a profound act of service and devotion, reflecting the deep reverence for the Body and Blood of Christ. Understanding the responsibilities and significance of EMOHCs can deepen our appreciation for this ministry and inspire those called to serve.

The Purpose and Need for Extraordinary Ministers to assist in the distribution of Holy Communion when there are not enough ordained ministers (bishops, priests and deacons) to serve the congregation. This need often arises in parishes with large congregations or during special liturgical celebrations where the number of communicants is particularly high. The term “extraordinary” highlights that this role is supplementary and not a replacement for the ordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Please contact Fr. ### Have you chosen the better part?

In today's reading the question is, "have you chosen the better part." Martha was only doing what she thought was expected of her but Mary on the other hand was sitting at the foot of Jesus listening to every word.

Every week we come to Mass and listen to the reading of the books of the prophets, the Apostles, and words of God. We pray and receive the body and blood of Jesus. We get to absorb and enrich ourselves and open our hearts to the love that God has for us. But is receiving better than giving? Do we accept these gifts and not share them? Is that enough to foster a gift which has changed the way we live our lives and not share that joy with others?

Jesus sent out his disciples who received his words to people who were too busy to open their hearts to the love that created them. We also, as his followers, are called to lead and bring others to the peace and joy we have received from him.

How does this journey start? We listen to learn and learn to act. It can be more about what we do than what we say. In every reading there is a lesson to follow. These actions can be kindness, joy are duty. We learn to give rather than to receive. It can be more effective to teach than to roar. By following the example that we learned from Jesus, we are choosing the better part and leading others to join us.

**Community** – the love and caring of each other,

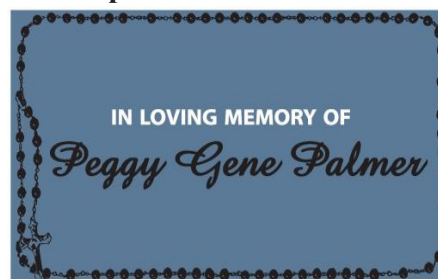
**Theology** – the study of God through scripture and the Catholic Faith,


