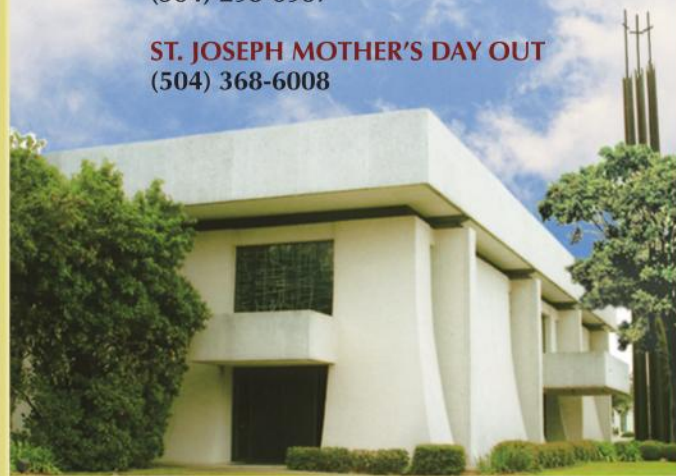

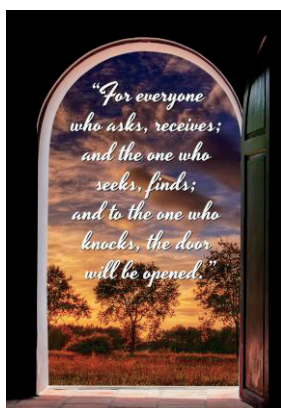

When do we pray?

Let us step into the time of Jesus and look at the culture of His day. One of the most important values of this time was hospitality especially to travelers. You see there were no Holiday Inns or Burger Kings on the roads at that time. So, we can see why the man, who was caught off guard by his unexpected visitors, went to a neighbor's house for help. All of us have unexpected and unprepared things that happen in our lives and need to call on someone for help. Jesus is telling us in this parable do not be afraid to call upon him and his father but most importantly to be persistent in our request.

If you are one who have called on Jesus many, many times when you were faced with problems that you were not prepared for and have followed his suggestion and continued praying until they are resolved. One of the things that you would have learned was that the process of praying takes the solution out of your hands and puts it in his, which in itself is a relief. As we pray, we become more dependent on Jesus which is one of the things that He wants and who is more powerful to manage our problems than Him. Sometimes it takes a long time for a response, but we must realize that maybe He has answered our prayers and simply said that he has a better solution or a different plan than we have.

Luke ends his Gospel today with the reassurance that God would never answer our prayers with something that would harm us. Our father would never give his child a snake or a scorpion.

Pray, pray, spend the time, and remember that God always answers our prayers but not always in our time or with what we prayed for. He does know what is best for us.

When do we pray? Always!
