



#### Choices

In today's reading by Luke, Jesus is asked to become an arbitrator, a very difficult but highly respected role in the culture of that time. Problems of the kind that he was asked to negotiate could escalate into violent clashes between the parties involved and even blood could be shed. An arbitrator was chosen because of his status, respect and influence and his decision would be obeyed. Jesus wanted no part of the controversy and would never interfere in matters concerning money.

The parable that Jesus sited was one that showed the greed and self-centeredness of the landowner. The landowner never saw beyond himself. He could have become a patron and distributed his wealth but instead he decided to horde his good fortune. When God gives us talent and wealth, we should remember that it is from God and use it to spread God's love. The rich man did not see beyond this world. All of his endeavors were made for this life with no thought of what happens next.

This life is full of choices and problems that we must overcome. Some are easy and some are very difficult. Remember that the choices and the results of the decisions are temporary. All of the conclusions we draw will affect our character and reflect in our heart.

Now let me tell you a story about this young executive who was on a business flight and was very pleased with his success in life. As the flight progressed it was time for a meal to be served. The elderly flight attendant told the young man what was being served. His arrogant response to her was, what are not my options? Her kindly response was yes or no. Unlike the young executive in the story, when we choose an action or get caught up in someone else's action the sure way to choose correctly is to ask the advice of God. So, when you get stressed out go to God.

The answer is simple. All we have to do is get on the same page as God. Know that God is with you every minute of the day and let this allow you to serve the Lord with gladness throughout the day no matter what happens. Remember that this life is short and to prove it just think about how fast our children have grown up. Or better yet, how fast our birthdays come and go.
