

Are you Listening?

In the Gospel today, Jesus speaks about another commitment, a commitment to Him. We must "Strive to enter through the narrow gate." As a community of faith, we must realize that the only way to enter that gate is through prayer. In the latter years in this life, it should have become clearer and clearer to us each day. When we pray, I am not talking about coming to mass, making the sign of the cross, genuflecting, saying the Our Father, and leaving. I can guarantee this will not take you to the Golden Gate. You might find yourself on the other side of the locked door. It can become easy to find ourselves praying in that fashion because we have become too busy to set aside time to pray. In the world today, that can become normal but think about how temporary our time here is, and how permanent the hereafter is.

Prayer is a conversation with God. You can speak and listen. Sometimes it does not seem like he is listening but if you listen you will be able to see his answer in your actions, peace in times of normal anxiety, comfort in the time of unrest, and caring for others that you normally ignore.

The only way we are going to spend this time in prayer is when you set aside time each day to get to know God better. We may spend time with other things we do daily but the time we put aside for God should be at the top of our schedule. Think about your daily routine, and make room for you to pray. Once you get it into your daily agenda, you will start to notice how you are sensing God's presence in your actions and how you are able to overlook the thing that upset you before.


