A Time for Love

In the news a week or so ago there was a story about a 17-year young pregnant girl shot by an older man because of road rage. The baby was saved but the mother was not. Then there was the story of a man who shot up a Catholic church killing two children and wounding many more. Now you might ask how this can be a story about love. Sometimes stories have an unusual start to give us a sense of purpose of the subject. I was reading a book about a prophet who was being questioned by a man of faith who quoted the bible by asking him about "Jesus commanding his disciples to love each other as he loved them." The man's question to the prophet was, "how do you love?" The answer, although it seems simple, needs to be understood that love is not a feeling but an action. There are feelings in love, but the real part of love is commitment, commitment to action. The prophet's answer was the best definition of love is that it makes us the best person that we can be. Love is not only something that you give it is something that you live. The first step of love is to spend time with God ideally every day for he is the source of love. Then it is for us to treat others with love. It can be calling a friend or relative just to ask how they are doing. You can be kind and helpful to people you just meet in the store. It can be by coming to full stop at a stop sign or obeying the speed limit. It is to ask yourself what Jesus would do? These all might seem like simple things, and they are once you get started. As time goes on in our lives it seems that our time seems more limited. Remember time is just a measurement of change and now is a good time to seek to become the best person you can be.
