COACHING



We invest in a handful of Catholic leaders at one time, through two coaching models: **CMD Cohorts** and **CMD Circles**.

CMD Cohorts is a year-long process with an existing Catholic leadership team. It is intense, deep, and highly effective.

CMD Circles consists of six weeks of coaching Catholic professionals through formation in evangelization and missionary discipleship skills.

NATIONAL INITIATIVES

Marcel LeJeune, President and Founder of Catholic Missionary Disciples, has served as a member of the Advisory Council for the National Eucharistic Congress in the past year. The Congress is now overseeing the continued implementation of the National Eucharistic Revival (which started in 2022) and the next National Eucharistic Congress, which will be in 2029.

Marcel is also participating in several other national initiatives, including the planning for the international celebration of the 2,000th anniversary of Jesus' death and resurrection in 2033, a member of the planning committee of a U.S. Bishops initiative to empower more leaders as evangelists and missionary disciples, and regular gatherings of apostolate leaders who work in parish renewal.
