


Preparing for tax season?


TA[†]DS can help!

You can access your *Household Paid Tuition Tax Report* under the Billing tab in TADS. This report provides a breakdown of the payments made for your family during a specific tax year. Below are step-by-step instructions.

- Step 1: Log into your TADS user account.
- Step 2: Click on the "Billing" tab.
- Step 3: Click on "Household Paid Tuition Tax Report" on the left side of the screen.



Step 4: Complete the prompt to fill in the correct tax year and click "Submit."



Step 5: Once submitted, a PDF will be produced that outlines all payments made that year. This can be downloaded and printed as needed.

Why: Camp is an awesome opportunity for our young people to get away from distractions, have fun, encounter the Lord and develop friendships.


