In continued efforts to make your experience more secure, SchoolSpeak has enhanced the security protocol regarding password safety and encryption. What does this mean for you? ALL account users need to login to their SchoolSpeak account as soon as possible. If you always keep your account open on your device, you need to log off on all devices and log back in to preserve your password. You should also keep your username and password in a safe place for reference. Any account users who do not login by June 1st passwords will automatically reset. You will still have the ability to gain access to your SchoolSpeak account by selecting Forgot Password or contacting SchoolSpeak. By following these steps now you will avoid having your password changed.

Why: Camp is an awesome opportunity for our young people to get away from distractions, have fun, encounter the Lord and develop friendships.


