





Beloved Child: Believe

See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God: and so we are...Beloved, we are God's children now; it does not yet appear what we shall be, but we know that when He appears we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is... (1 John 3:1-3) Keeping this in mind is as essential as three meals a day and eight hours of sleep a night: mental, physical, and spiritual health are interwoven. When one part suffers, all parts suffer, and we are all connected. Although Jesus used a natural example, it's plenty plain to understand:

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in me, and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5)

Henri J. M. Nouwen offers an interesting and personal perspective on what can be the greatest trap in a person's life. It's not worldly success, popularity, or power, but self-rejection.



"When we have come to believe in the voices that call us worthless

and unlovable, then success, popularity and power are easily perceived as attractive solutions. As soon as someone accuses me or criticizes me, as soon as I am rejected, left alone, or abandoned, I find myself thinking, 'Well, that proves once again that I am a nobody.' And my dark side says, 'I am no good...I deserve to be pushed aside, forgotten, rejected, and abandoned.' Self-rejection is the greatest enemy of the spiritual life because it contradicts the sacred voice that call us the "Beloved". Being the "Beloved" constitutes the core of our existence.

Consider signing up for a weekly hour at the Visitation Adoration Chapel. There, you can learn that you are precious in God's eyes, that he calls you "Beloved" from all eternity.

Rite (Order) of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you interested in becoming Catholic?
Or were you baptized Catholic but never received First
Communion and/or Confirmation?

Then the RCIA / OCIA is for you.

It is the Church's official process for fully initiating adults into the Catholic faith, and is for:

- 1) Those who have never been baptized.
- 2) Those who were baptized and/or raised in another Christian church and now want to become Catholic.
- Baptized Catholics who never completed their initiation through the sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

Sundays Sept 10th, 17th, & 24th 10:30 – 11:30 am Madonna Room (by vestibule of church)

Facilitator: Matt Pozen (Director of Faith Formation).

After the Initial Inquiry Meetings, the regular sessions will take place each week on Sunday morning until the Easter Vigil (March 30th), when the candidates will receive the sacraments and be fully initiated into the Catholic Church.

Each Sunday at the 9:30 Mass: Starting Sept. 24th

The Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) program is starting up again at Visitation during the 9:30 am Sunday Mass. It is for children age 4 through 4th grade.

How does CLOW work?

At the beginning of Mass the priest invites the children forward and gives them a blessing. Then an adult leader and teen helper walk them out of church into the Parish Center. (Parents may go with their children the first few times if they are apprehensive.) The leader proclaims the Scripture readings to the children and does a brief activity to help them understand. Then leaders walk the children back into church while the collection is being taken up, and make sure the children return to sitting with their parents.
