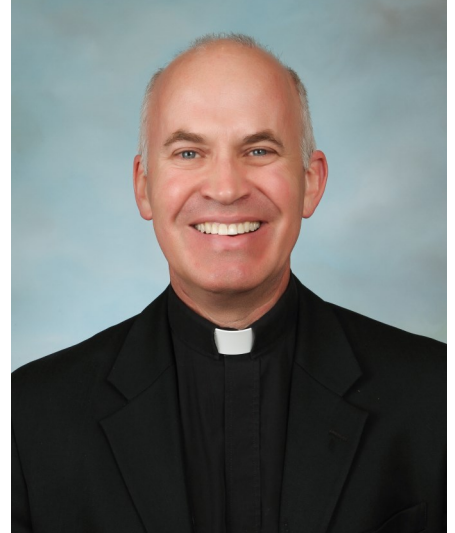

A LETTER FROM FATHER BEAU

Dear Parishioners,

Between the latter part of April and May, we had the great opportunity to offer Adoration in our parking lot at St. Angela. Under COVID-19 restrictions at that time, we moved to our parking lot so that precautions could be observed as people prayed in their cars.

We were blessed with many helpers. Our Knights of Columbus helped to organize our cars as they moved into the lot. Kimberly Mouledoux played classical guitar and her friend Marjorie Garnier played violin to offer beautiful musical support. Kimberly's husband, Guy, set up our sound system so that everyone could hear. Eric Broadbridge built a wooden altar specifically designed for the top of our ramp. Deacon David Aaron led our parking lot congregation in the Holy Hour, walking with the monstrance up the ramp to the top landing. Fr. Dan and I offered Confessions an hour before Adoration and stayed in our Conference Room Confessional through the Holy Hour. The whole experience was sacred and at the same time unique.



The feedback from those who attended was incredible. We had strong support based on the number of cars in the lot. The most amount of parked cars was 101. The least amount of cars was 65. When you consider that a number of cars carried more people than the driver, the numbers climb.

The unique experience drew many new faces to Wednesday Adoration. They had the opportunity to have a Face-to-face encounter with the Risen Lord. The Eucharist is the heart of Jesus, whose heart stands open and vulnerable for all to see.

The vulnerability of God that amazes me. In the Sacred Host, Jesus allows Himself to be consumed by us in Holy Communion. In Adoration, placed behind glass in the Monstrance, we are allowed to behold Him in the Eucharist. We have the great opportunity to encounter the Risen Lord.

I want to invite you to Adoration on Wednesdays at 6pm. The Holy Hour is silent, giving you the opportunity to let what is in your mind and heart come to the surface, and at the same open it up to Jesus in prayer. Jesus sets the example, being on the altar in vulnerability, and He invites you and me to take the time with Him and do the same.

When St. Peter fell asleep in the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus asked, "So you could not keep watch with me for one hour?" (Mt. 26:40) I can remember praying a Holy Hour at the Abbey years ago. In the silence, I felt like nothing was happening, but I was committed to praying the Holy Hour. I clearly remember receiving a tremendous insight in the last 2 minutes of the Holy Hour. It was a breakthrough that God initiated. I was glad that I completed the hour. I committed to a daily Holy Hour 4 years ago, and it has become a non-negotiable in my life.

I say all of this, because you and I are invited to more. We are made for more.

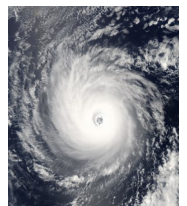

Saint of the Week

**SAINT JOHN FISHER
(1469-1535) AND
SAINT THOMAS MORE
(1477-1535)**

Feast Day: June 22

From Robert Bolt's classic *A Man for All Seasons* to *Showtime's* edgy *The Tudors*, Thomas More endears himself still: lawyer-statesman of impeccable integrity, remarried widower and affectionate father delighting in a lively household—four children, a pet monkey, even a paid jester! And challenges still: humanist-reformer, yet champion of Catholic faith and papal primacy. John Paul II named him Patron of Statesmen and Politicians, citing More's generous work, both as a lawyer and in government service, on behalf of the poorest and most marginalized people of his time, as well as his promotion of education for all sectors of society. More's decision for principle over politics, conscience over convenience prompted his final words: "I die the king's good servant, but God's first." Alone among England's bishops, John Fisher dared challenge Henry VIII's divorce and repudiation of the papacy. When the Pope named the imprisoned Fisher a cardinal, Henry thundered: "Don't bother sending Fisher's red hat here; I'll send Fisher's head to Rome!" Whose "good servants" are we first? Isn't a right conscience worth the pain of standing alone?

We are living through unprecedented times facing a health crisis that affects our city, country and world. Many families also face additional risks in financial security. For example, the loss of jobs through business closures or through a need to care for a family member creates a financial hardship for many, a hardship that will take some time to overcome.

That's why we've created **ST. ANGELA'S ANGELS**, dedicated to bringing tuition assistance to our school families during these difficult times. We want to make sure all of our families can return to school for the 2020-2021 school year.

St. Angela parish and school are uniquely intertwined into a community dedicated to Catholic education. We want to ensure that St. Angela Merici Catholic School, which builds leaders for tomorrow, continues to thrive for generations.

Who would I be helping?

The program will be offered to families enrolled at St. Angela in 2019-2020, who wish to have their children continue in 2020-2021, and have a specific and unforeseen financial hardship caused by the pandemic.

What else is the School doing?

The school's leadership is working through its budget and evaluating how it will balance its income and expenses for next year. Maintaining an affordable tuition rate has been and will remain a priority for our school. In addition, we will continuously review expenses to make sure operating costs are controlled.

Who will decide who gets assistance?

Applications will be reviewed and allocation decisions will be made by the church and school leadership. The program is geared towards currently-enrolled St. Angela Merici families and will be based on need.

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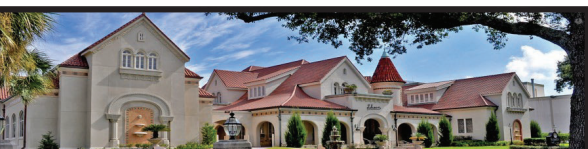
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
