St. Paul's Scholarship Donations Needed

St. Paul's Catholic School in Barton needs donations for their scholarship fund. The scholarship fund was started with a bequest from Lucille LaMothe which supplied needsbased scholarships from 2012 to 2015. The school has the potential to receive a bequest in



a year or two in the form of a small endowment. Thus, in a few years the scholarship fund could have an annual income of several thousand dollars per year and be self-supporting. While this is wonderful news for the future. scholarship funds are currently depleted, and St. Paul's must rely totally on individual donors for 2018 and 2019. Sponsorship of a full scholarship is \$3600, but any amount toward a partial scholarship would be most welcome and greatly appreciated.
