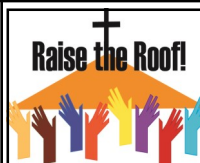

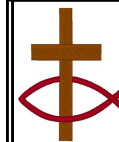

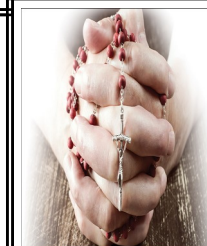
RCIA Coming Soon! Fall of 2018 RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

St. Paul's Scholarship Donations Needed

St. Paul's Catholic School in Barton needs donations for their scholarship fund. The scholarship fund was started with a bequest from Lucille LaMothe which supplied needs-based scholarships from 2012 to 2015. The school has the potential to receive a bequest in a year or two in the form of a small endowment. Thus, in a few years the scholarship fund could have an annual income of several thousand dollars per year and be self-supporting. While this is wonderful news for the future, scholarship funds are currently depleted, and St. Paul's must rely totally on individual donors for 2018 and 2019. Sponsorship of a full scholarship is \$3600, but any amount toward a partial scholarship would be most welcome and greatly appreciated.
