

## Easter Blessings from the Vocationist Fathers


The Resurrection of the Lord fills our hearts and minds with joy and gratitude. It is in this same spirit of thanksgiving that we wish all the parishioners of Mater

### **Easter Sunday**

Today's readings identify what Christ's Crucifixion and Resurrection gained for those who believe. The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles summarizes Jesus' life from His baptism, to the good works and healings He performed, to His death on the Cross and finally His



Resurrection. The reading concludes with the pronouncement that everyone who believes in Jesus will receive forgiveness of sins through His name. In the second reading, St. Paul tells us to think of what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God, not of what is on earth, so that when Jesus comes again, we can appear with Him in glory. In John's Gospel, we read about Mary Magdalene's shock and fear when she visited Jesus' tomb and found the stone removed and His body gone. She ran to find Simon Peter and "the disciple whom Jesus loved" to tell them that the Lord's body had been taken from the tomb. Peter and the other unnamed disciple probably John - ran to the tomb and found the burial cloths set aside and the cloth covering His head rolled up in a separate place. The other disciple went in the tomb after Peter, saw, and believed. Remember that the Apostles did not vet understand the Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead.
