

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time Losing To Gain

After Peter answered Jesus, "You are the Christ"...God's anointed," Jesus called himself "Son of man." Jesus acknowledges the weakness of the



acknowledges the weakness of the human nature he has assumed, and this enables our humanity to proclaim the divinity within. (St. Bede)

Then Jesus extends a difficult invitation to deny oneself to follow Him. It is hard to forget oneself and choose others' interests. Saint Augustine tells us that what is difficult in the command, love makes easy. We are lost because of love of self. We are found in self-denial. The Cross is the only weapon we are given to follow Jesus. Only slaves were required to carry a cross. A slave belongs to a master. Becoming a slave enables us to humble ourselves to follow the Master.
