



### MATER DEI FOOD SHELF NEWS & NOTES



To date in 2023, the Mater Dei Food Shelf has distributed close to 350 bags of food and personal items to

those in need. It is so rewarding to see how our food shelf is addressing the needs of those in our area who are experiencing food insecurity. We are grateful to the many parishioners who continue to donate items and/or gifts of money to support our mission.

However, with the increase in distribution, we are experiencing a shortage of food shelf items and are in need of donations of the following items: cereal, oatmeal packets, canned pasta, tuna fish, peanut butter, rice and pasta quick mixes, crackers, ramen noodles/soup mixes, hearty soups (not condensed), broth, hygiene & toiletry products, toilet paper/paper towels, garbage bags and laundry detergent.

Non-essential specialty items such as microwave popcorn, pudding/jello, granola bars, baking mixes, jelly and dressings, for example, are also always appreciated to add variety to the choices available. Truly any donation is greatly appreciated.

There are totes in the back of each of the churches and in the entryway at St. Edward's to collect items, or you can drop donations off in the entryway at St. Mary's Rectory or at the parish office in Derby Line during office hours. We are also happy to pick up items if that is more convenient.
