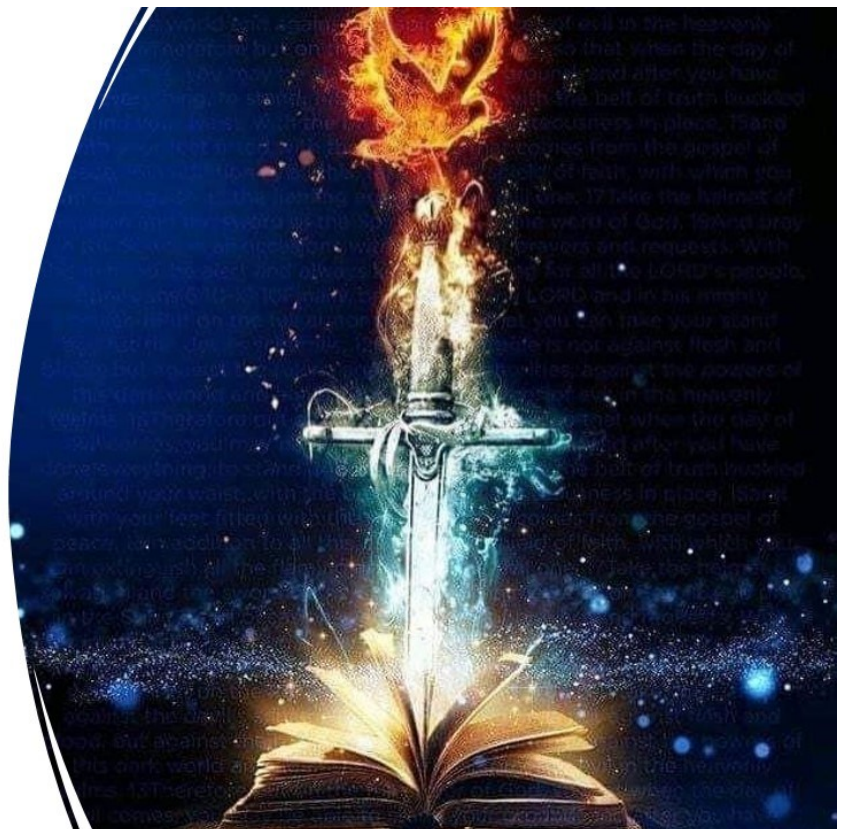




## Hebrew 4:12




# Isaiah 40:29-31

your life.



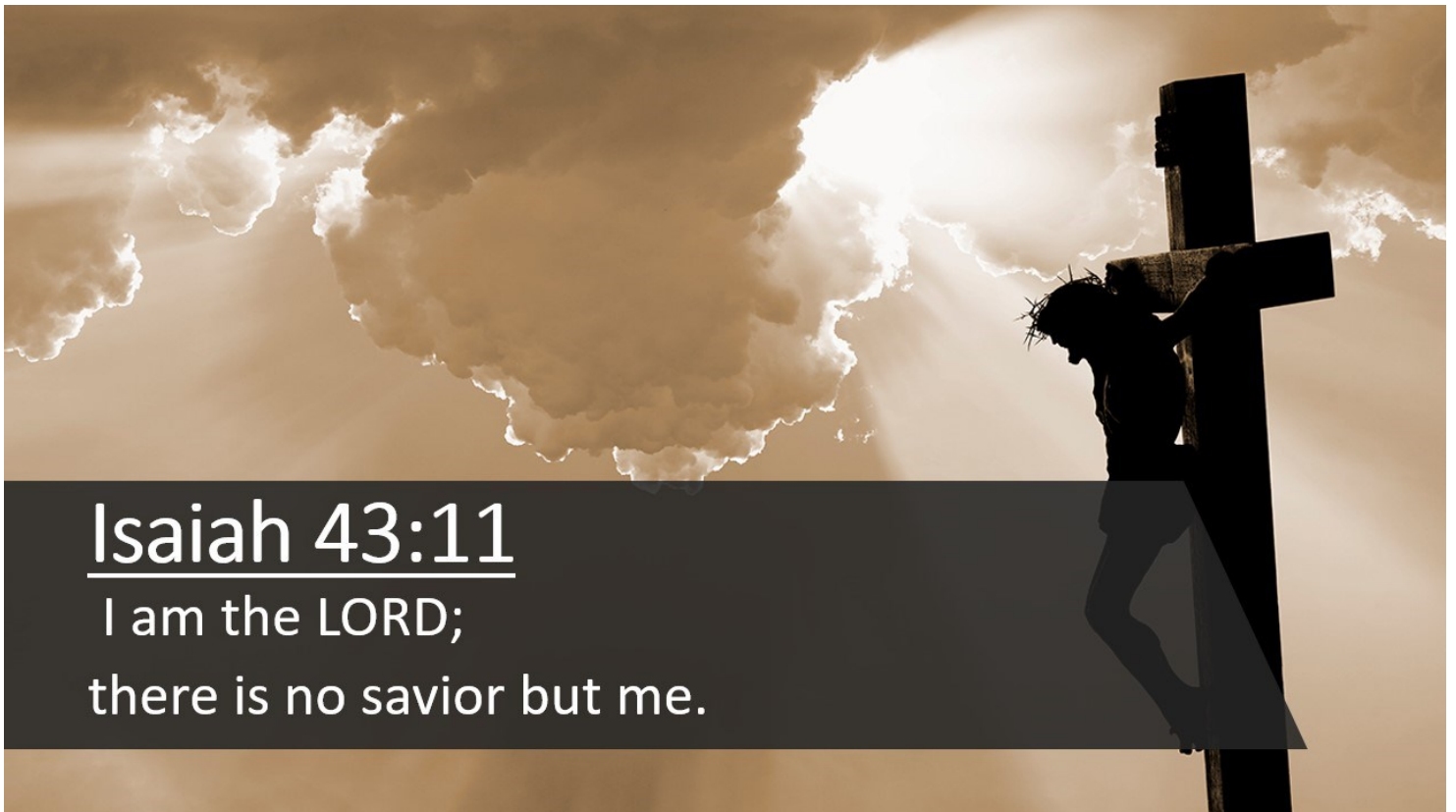

## Isaiah 43:25

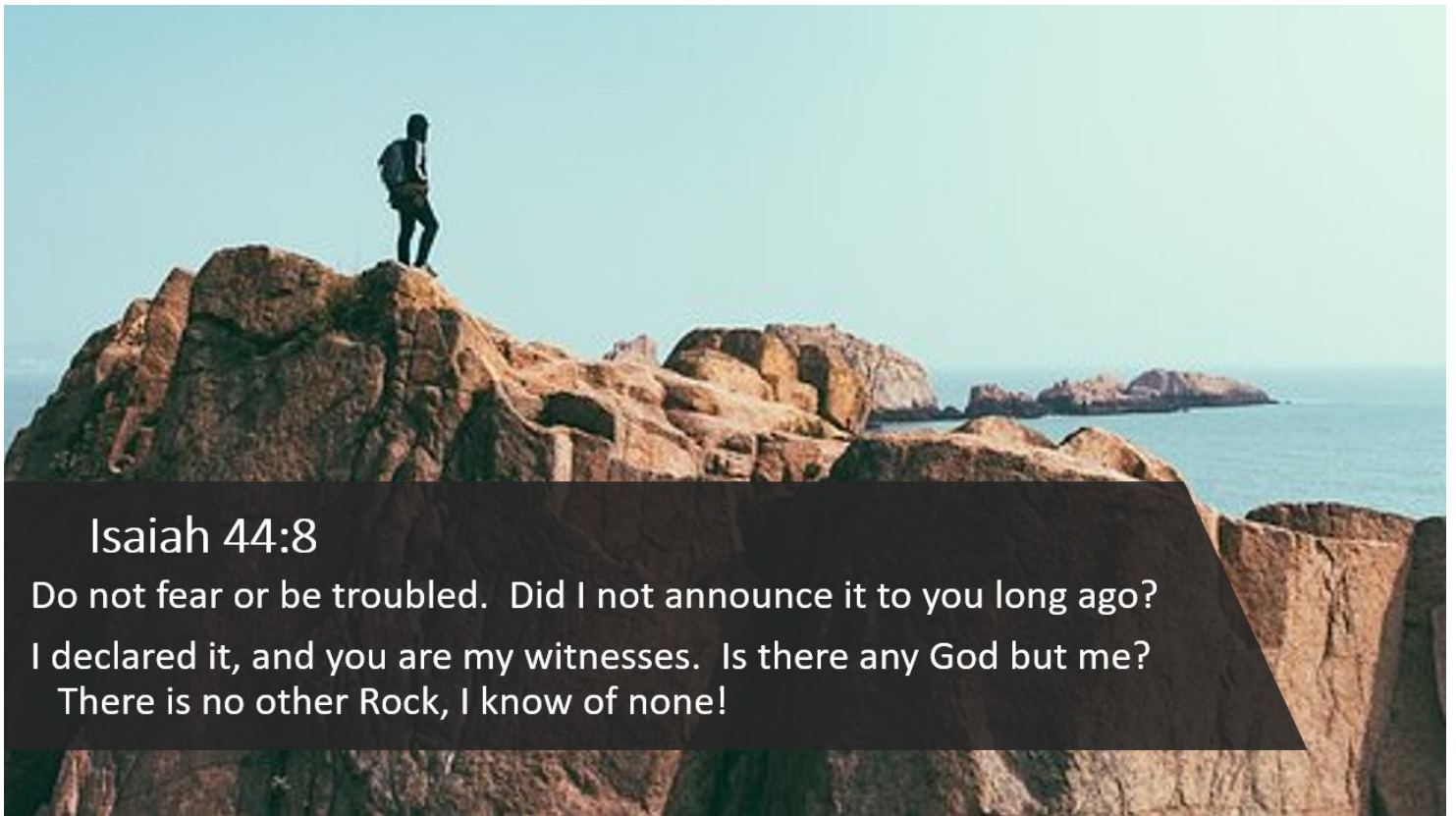

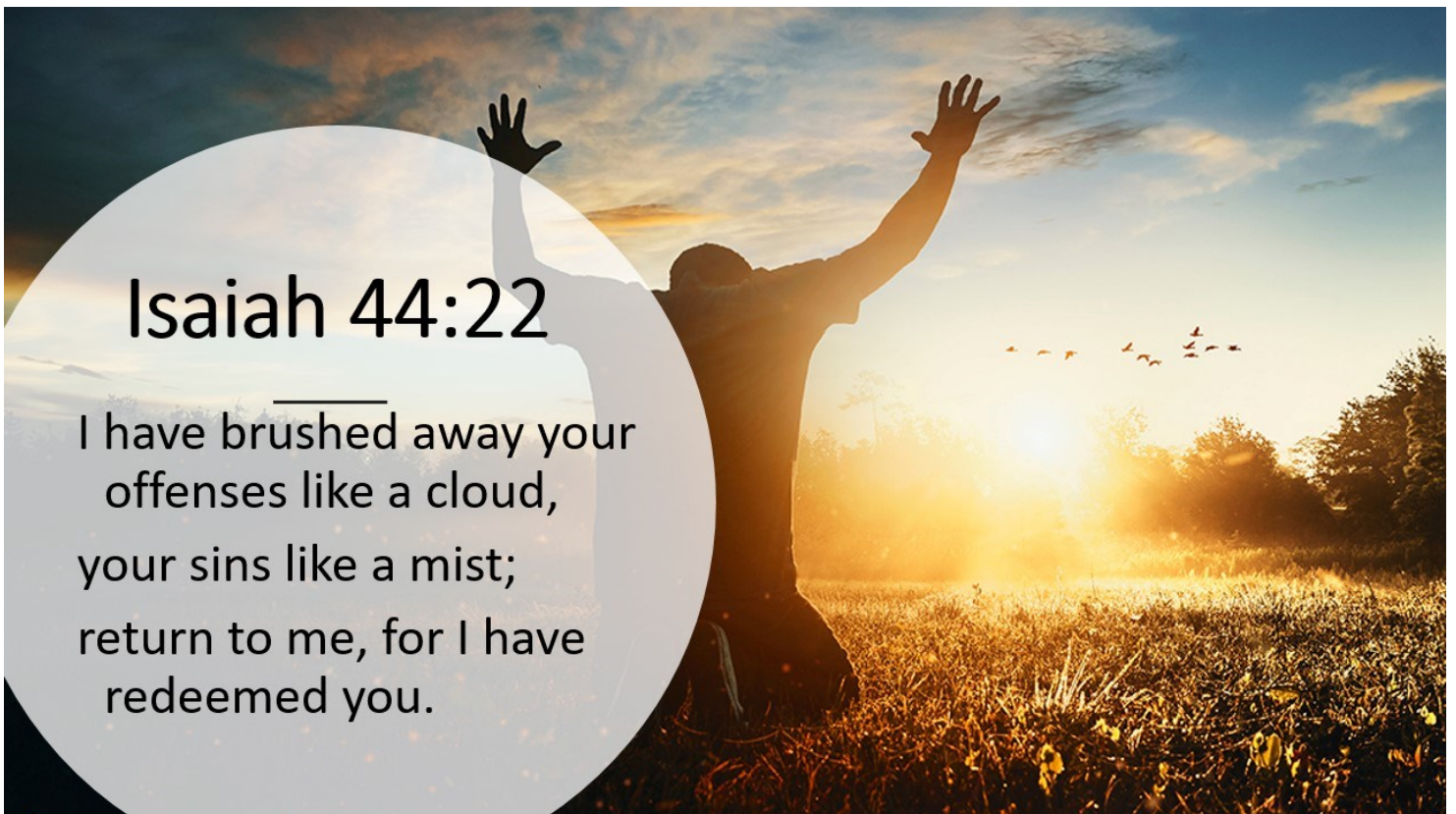






## Isaiah 44:8

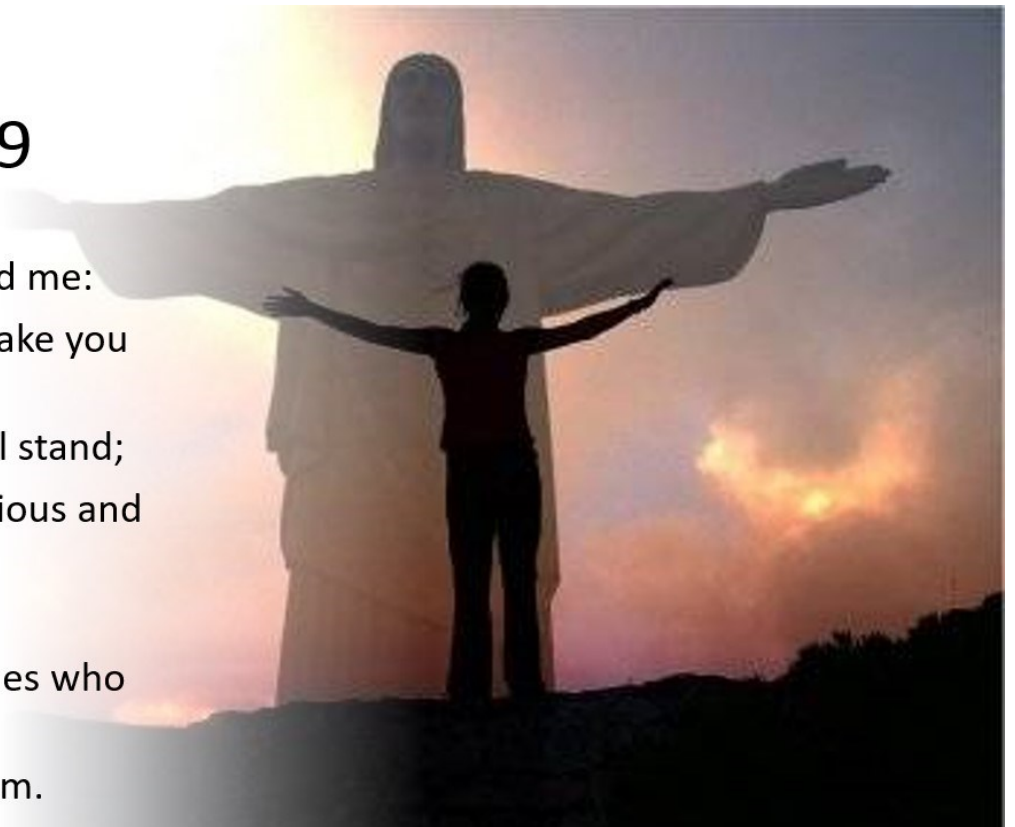

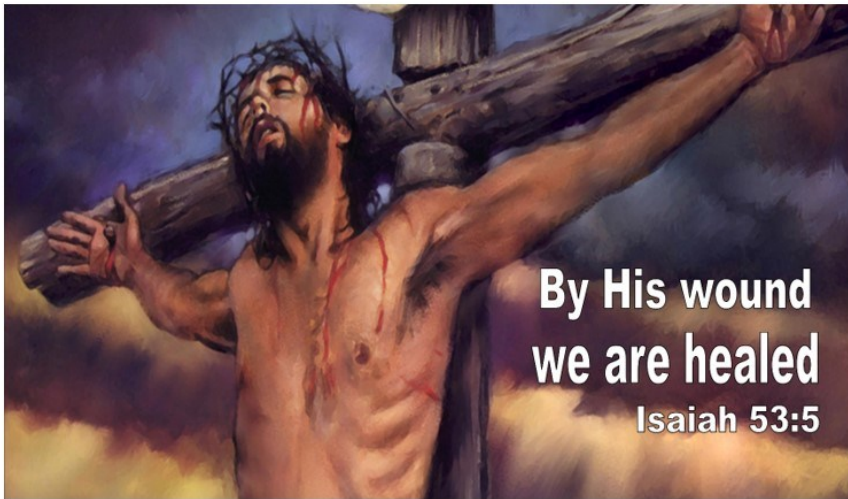

**The light of Israel will become a fire, its holy one a flame, which will burn and devour its thorns and thistles in a single day.**

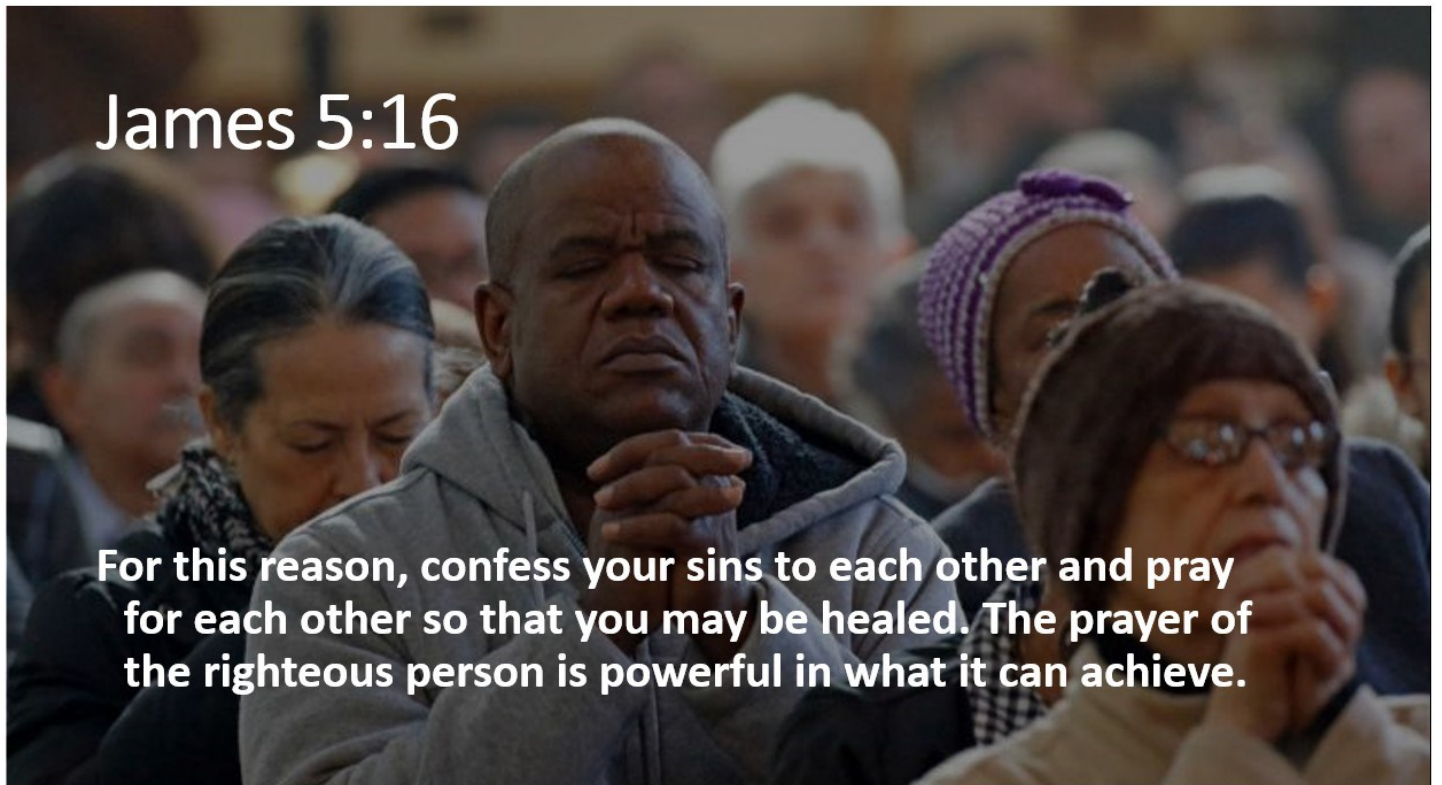
## Exodus 23:25-26

Many signs and wonders were done among the people at the hands of the apostles. They were all together in Solomon's portico.



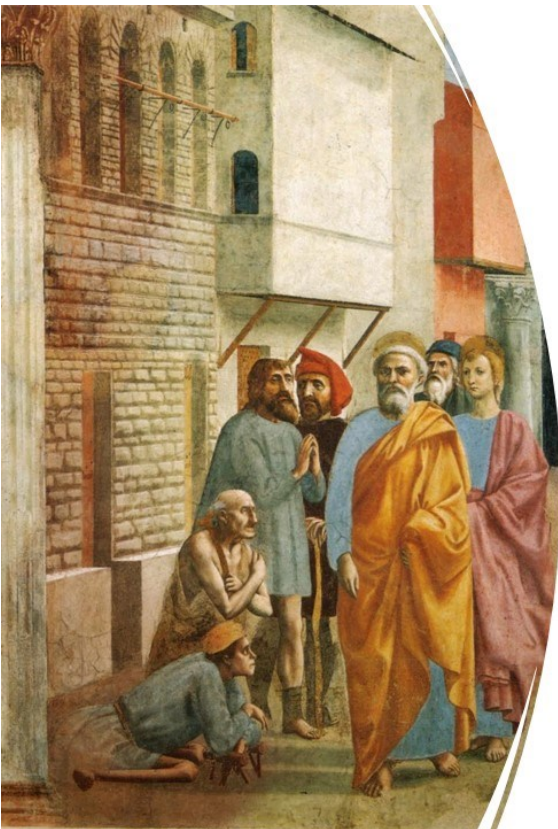




## Acts 19:11-12 (Healing with Clothes)

Peter said, "I have neither silver nor gold, but what I do have I give you: in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean, [rise and] walk."

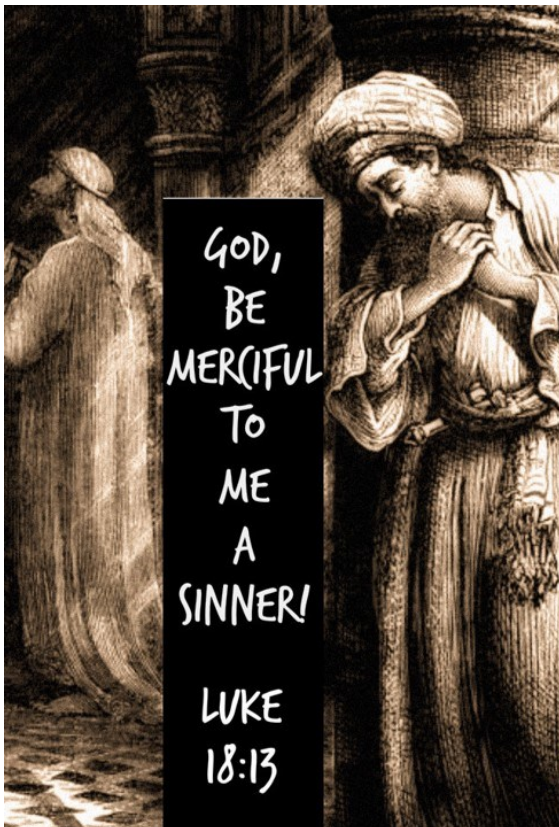
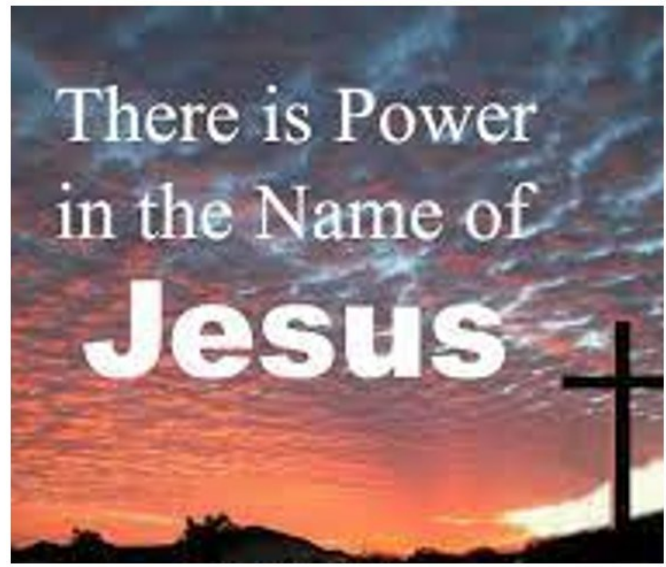


## Acts 4:29-31

**34** then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "*Ephphatha!*" (that is, "Be opened!")

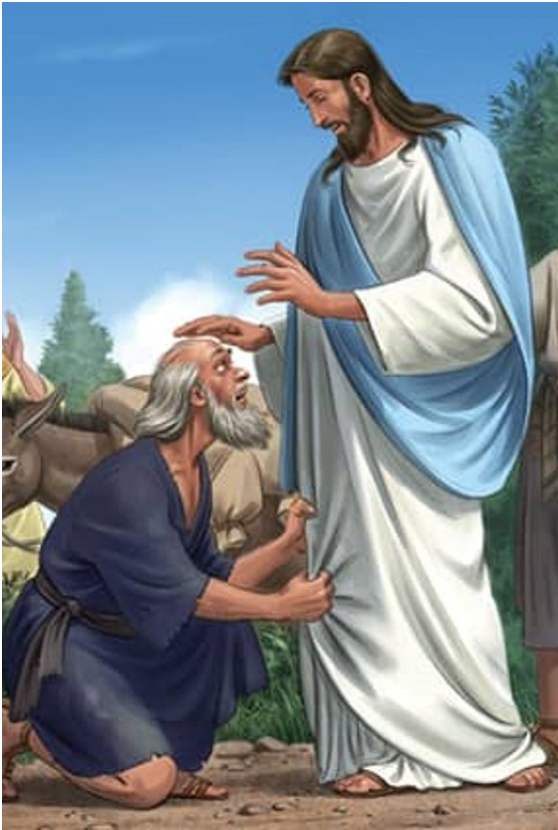
**35** And [immediately] the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly.

I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the LORD. They shall be my people and I will be their God, for they shall return to me with their whole heart.

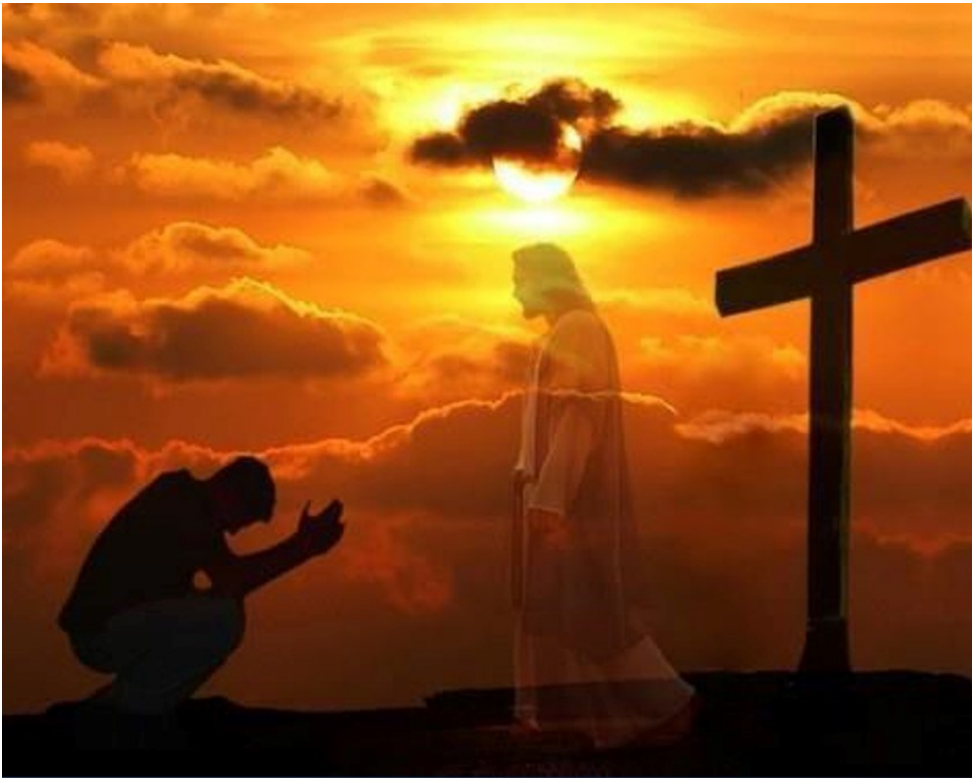


# 2 Chronicles

41 And indeed, we have been condemned justly, for the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes, but this man has done nothing criminal."

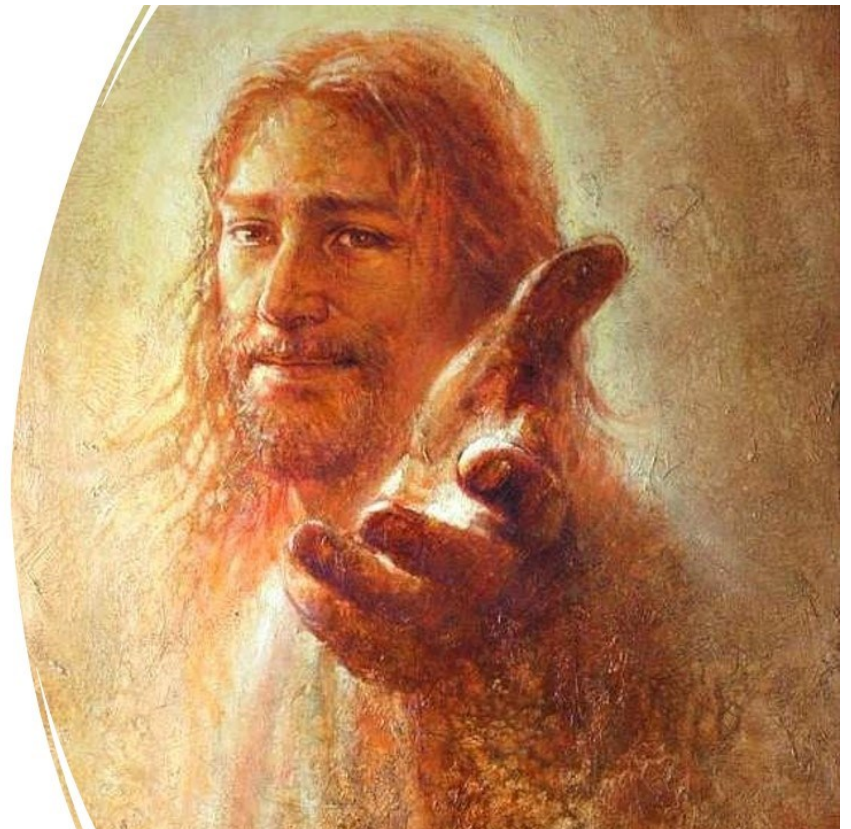
**42 Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."**

the accusing finger, and malicious speech;

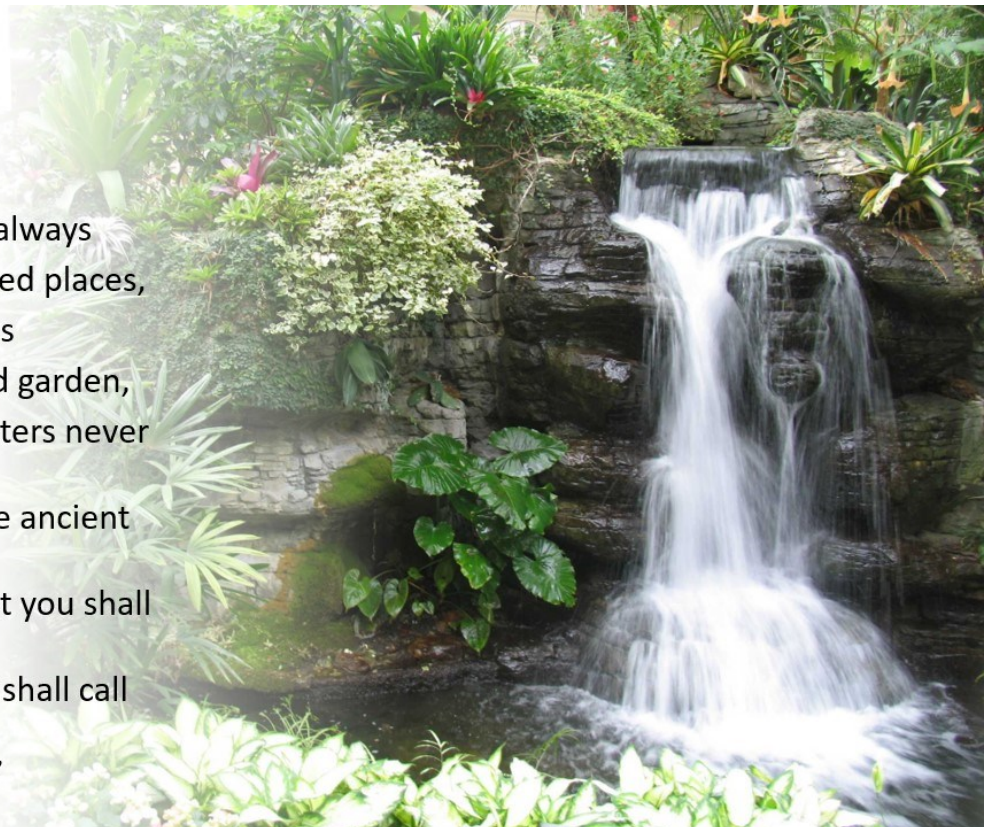
## Isaiah 58:11-12
