living liturgy

"The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the Gospel."

Today's readings tell us of God's great love

for us. In the first reading from the Book of Exodus, God tells us how He took the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt, and promised that if they obeyed His Covenant, they would be treasured possessions of God. Today's Responsorial Psalm calls all of us to praise and serve the Lord joyfully. In the second reading from St. Paul to the Romans, God showed His love for humanity by sending His Son, Jesus Christ, to die for our sins. Through Jesus' sacrifice, we can be reconciled with God and receive the gift of Eternal Life. In today's Gospel, Matthew tells us of Jesus' compassion for His people. Jesus sends out the twelve disciples to heal the sick, raise the dead, and proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom of Heaven. He encourages the disciples to serve others with love and generosity.

Are we following His commandments with joy and gratitude, or are we struggling to live up to God's standards? Sometimes the human side of us makes it difficult for us to live a life of obedience, but we can take comfort in the fact that God is with us every step of the way. He promised His people that He would be our God, and walk this journey of faith with us by guiding and strengthening us as we travel this road of faith.

We can evangelize, but to spread the light of Christ to others, we must first be able to see that shining light in our own lives. This means that we must live our lives in ways that reflect the love, compassion and mercy of Christ so that others draw Jesus – the Light of Life – through us. We do not have to force our beliefs on others, but simply sharing the hope and joy we have found in Christ and inviting others to join us on this journey of faith is a good start.

Where do we see God shining light in our lives? Are there any areas of our lives where we are experiencing His love, mercy and grace? How can we share these experiences with others and use them to spread the light of Christ to those around us? When someone asks us to pray for them, take a moment and pray with them. When someone is in need, give of yourself – even if it is only for 10 minutes – to talk, pray or just listen. Be that person God wants us to be. We can also invite someone to join us at Mass, or attend a church event with us so we can share the joy of our faith with a community of believers.
