WE PRAY FOR OUR DEPARTED LOVED ONES DURING NOVEMBER




Throughout the month of November we remember our loved ones we have lost.

ST. MARY'S GARAGE CONSTRUCTION HAS BEGUN

WORK CONTINUES ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW GARAGE NEXT TO THE CHURCH. THE

OLD GARAGE HAS BEEN DEMOLISHED AND THE FOUNDATION HAS BEEN LAID FOR THE NEW ONE. THE COST OF THE DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION IS ESTIMATED AT \$25,000.
