What must I do to inherit Eternal Life?

When we talk about God, our limited human experiences often fall short of capturing His infinite nature. However, a fundamental truth of our faith is clear: through Jesus Christ, we have been offered redemption. He made peace through His sacrifice and showed us how to live for Eternal Life.

In his Letter to the Colossians, Paul references an early Christian hymn that succinctly teaches who Jesus is – both human and divine, the God-man through whom all creation is made and redeemed. Only God can forgive and offer salvation, which is why He sent His Son to suffer and die for us, demonstrating the depth of His love.

Paul emphasizes that Jesus has redeemed us from sin and death, leading us to the freedom of being God's children and the promise of Eternal Life. Today's Gospel presents the question of Eternal life, answered by Jesus through the parable of the Good Samaritan: we are called to love one another as Christ loves us.

As we embrace this redemption, our challenge is to live according to Christ's commands and respond to His offer of life by loving the Lord and our neighbors. Let us hear and understand Jesus' mandate, and act accordingly.

Heavenly Father, I come before You today to ask for Your guidance and blessings. I know that You are the source of all love, and I humble myself before You. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit that I may always remember Your love for me. Grant me the strength to love You with my whole heart, mind, and soul.

O Father, also grant me the heart to love others as You love me. Help me to see their struggles and joys, embrace their differences, and to build a community grounded in kindness and compassion. Let Your love flow through me, uniting me in harmony and peace with You. Amen.
