

Incoming Second Grade Summer Work 25/26

Reading

Read at least 5 books (on your reading level). Then choose 3 activities below (1 activity per book). Assignments will be due on **Friday, August 29th**.

For your summer reading, keep a reading log/journal of the books you have read. Include the title(s), a one-sentence summary of each, and write two or three new words you have learned from your reading. Summer work will be graded as a project and worth 25 points. (5 points per book and activity).

Activities to choose from:

- Draw a picture of your favorite page. Explain in a paragraph why this page is your favorite.
- Use an index card to summarize the book you have read. On the other side of the index card, write to explain why you would recommend this book to a friend.
- Make a picture timeline of all the events in the book and describe each picture in a sentence.
- Create a puppet or finger puppet about your favorite character. Write a paragraph describing your favorite character.
- Make up another beginning and ending for the story. Include pictures/drawings.
- Cut out magazine pictures to make a collage or poster illustrating the main idea of the book. Write a paragraph describing the main idea.
- Draw a portrait of the main character and write a one paragraph summary to go with your sketch.
- Draw a comic strip of your favorite scene.
