18th Sunday in Ordinary Time-Jesus knows the intent of the crowd who relentlessly followed him. He had fed them, and now they wanted to know more. The crowd asks him a series of three questions. In the first, they only want to know when he arrived across the sea. In the second, they

want to know what their part is in accomplishing God's works. To this Jesus replies, believe in the one God sent. In the third question, the crowd asks Jesus for a sign so that they might believe in him. They reference their ancestors eating manna in the desert to substantiate their request. Jesus identifies himself as the Bread of Life. Whether the crowd understood what he was saying, John leaves unsaid.
