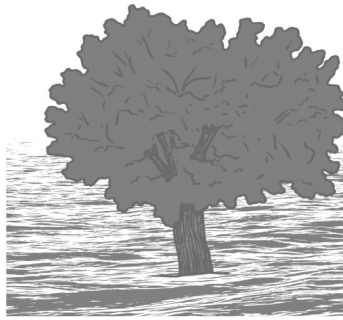
October 6, 2019 • Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus and the disciples had been together for quite some time when the apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." Even though they had witnessed the miracles, heard Jesus' teaching, and eaten with him at table, they sought greater faith in him. The same might be said for us. In the waters of baptism, we were drawn deeply to Christ and filled with the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, and still we often struggle to have faith, or enough faith, or the faith that we need in the circumstances of our daily lives. In his second letter to Timothy, Saint Paul urges us to rely on the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit, as we are challenged to live in faith and witness to the love of Christ. We hear this same sort of reliance on faith in today's first reading from Habakkuk: "For the vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint; if it delays, wait for it, it will surely come, it will not be late."

WHAT IS YOUR MULBERRY TREE?

We often limit what we believe we are capable of, rather than trusting that God will guide and strengthen us to do what we are called to do. A familiar phrase captures this sentiment: "God does not call the equipped, but equips the called." Uprooting a mulberry tree may seem impossible. So, at times, may living as a Christian in the world. What is your mulberry tree today? What situation needs you to take a leap of faith in order to respond in Christ's name? With faith and through the presence of the Holy Spirit, there is no limit to what we can do as Christian disciples.

Jesús y los discípulos ya tienen tiempo juntos cuando los apóstoles le dijeron al Señor "aumenta nuestra fe". Aunque ya habían presenciado los milagros, escuchado las enseñanzas de Jesús y compartido los alimentos con él, ellos buscaron una fe más grande en él. Lo mismo podría ser dicho por nosotros. En las aguas del Bautismo fuimos sumergidos profundamente en Cristo y llenados con la presencia del Espíritu Santo y aun así todavía luchamos para tener fe, o una fe suficiente, o la fe que necesitamos en las circunstancias de nuestra vida diaria. En la segunda carta a Timoteo, san Pablo nos anima a confiar en la fuerza y dones del Espíritu Santo, al ser desafiados a vivir con fe y dar testimonio del amor de Cristo. Escuchamos el mismo tipo de confianza en la fe en la primera lectura del libro de Habacuc "Es todavía una visión de algo lejano, pero que viene corriendo y no fallará; si se tarda, espéralo, pues llegará sin falta".

¿CUÁL ES TU ÁRBOL DE MORAS?

A menudo limitamos creer aquello de lo que somos capaces, en lugar de confiar que Dios nos guiará y fortalecerá hacer aquello a lo que estamos llamados a hacer. Una frase captura este sentimiento "Dios no llama a los mejor preparados, Dios prepara a los que él llama". Desentrañar un árbol de moras puede parecer imposible; al igual que algunas veces llevar una vida cristiana en el mundo. ¿Cuál es tu árbol de moras hoy? ¿En qué situación necesitas dar un salto de fe para poder responder en nombre de Cristo? Con fe y por medio de la presencia del Espíritu Santo, no hay límite de lo que podemos hacer como discípulos cristianos.
