Pastoral Letter

Out of the four Gospels in the New Testament, Mark is considered by experts as the oldest, that is the first, that was written. The audience to whom this book was written, were Jews that were becoming Christian. This Sunday's passage from Mark presents a very Jewish depiction: Rabbis discussing the right interpretation of the Mosaic Law, which was the work of a rabbi. Mark tells us that Jesus is approached by some Pharisees and asked him: "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" Mark continues to explain, that Jesus returns that question: "What did Moses command?" As Jesus explains elsewhere, He did not come to abolish the Law, but to bring it to fulfillment.

This Sunday is considered Life Sunday. And when we speak about life in the Church we are not just talking about biological life. We are referring to the vast components that give life to a human person: good health, relationships, etc. The strict and human interpretation of the Law that existed during the time of Jesus about marriage, was only in benefit to men, which regarded men as the only benefactors of social, religious and family life. Women, slaves, children, etc., did not enjoy the privilege of all these dimensions of life. Although various interpretations of these texts did exist, the overall understanding of that time, was that men had a prominent place in creation.

In the first reading from Genesis, we hear that God created every living creature. God's creation is presented to the man and he gives it a name. (In the Jewish mind, to name someone or something refers to understanding it or having access to it.) However, none of the living creatures "prove to be suitable partner" for the man that was created in the likeness of the Creator. The text from Genesis tells us that God acknowledges and creates an equal and suitable partner for the man: "This one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh." Both male and female are created equally in value and dignity.

The Pharisees that discussed with Jesus in today's Gospel, seek a human understanding of the Law, not the fulfillment of the Law that brings about the Kingdom of God. God for us Christians, is a unity-of-relationships: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. To be created in His image refers to being able to enter to and benefit from all dimensions of life-giving relationships. God acknowledged this from the beginning. Jesus reminds us in Mark that relationships with all and among all, should always be life-giving. Don't forget, Jesus was speaking of the fulfillment of the Law, not the fulfillment of Code of Canon Law.

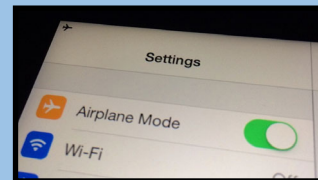

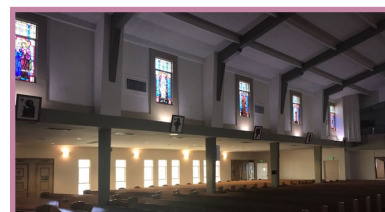
Prayer and Meditation

KNIGHTS OF DIPLOMACY By Andrew T. Walther

THE ORDER'S EFFORTS ON BEHALF OF CHRISTIANS TARGETED FOR GENOCIDE MOVED THE U.S. GOVERNMENT TO TAKE ACTION

On Oct. 24, 2017, the Knights of Columbus received an urgent call from Archbishop Bashar Warda of Erbil, Iraq. Due to a dispute over territory with the Kurdistan Regional Government, the Iraqi Army was prepared to shell the town of Teleskof — occupied by the Peshmerga, the military forces of Iraqi Kurdistan — the next morning. The town, 20 miles north of Mosul, had recently been rebuilt by the Hungarian government and resettled by approximately 1,000 Christian families. If Teleskof faced another assault, Archbishop Warda said, Christianity could come to an end in Iraq, since his people would no longer believe that Iraq was safe for them.

In response, the Knights immediately alerted the U.S. National Security Council (NSC), State Department and White House. Within hours, diplomatic interventions were underway. A senior state department official told the Knights that the U.S. Secretary of State was speaking with both the Iraqi and Kurdish prime ministers. The NSC further reported that they were contacting senior National Security leadership in Iraq. The threat of violence was de-escalated, and the Battle of Teleskof never occurred.

The Knights' quiet but decisive role in alerting key officials was made possible by the Order's ongoing efforts on behalf of Christians and other minority communities in the region — work that builds on the Order's long history of coming to the aid of those who are persecuted for their faith. In addition to humanitarian relief through the Knights' Christian Refugee Relief Fund, this work has included public awareness campaigns, such as the Week of Awareness for Persecuted Christians co-sponsored by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and several other organizations in November 2017.

Of particular significance has been the Knights' advocacy with the U.S. government and the United Nations on behalf of Christians and other minorities targeted for genocide, and the fruits of this work have continued to unfold.
