CHARITY UNITY FRATERNITY PATRIOTISM



Our Knights Leadership encourages us to be a "Can Do" organization!! I repeat the "Can Do" mantra in view of the efforts that brother knights put forth during this **COVID Pandemic** to give examples of Christian charity at the parish, county, state and national level. At St Josephs parish I am grateful for the donations of warm blankets and sleeping bags which our brothers donated last Saturday in support of a Deaconate outreach to the homeless (see photo, page 9). Saturday (2/27) was also the date that Orange County Knights conducted a chapter level Knights of Columbus Free Throw Competition to determine boy and girl winners at the county level and to establish scores for determination of State winners in the different age levels. My thanks to Felix Piro (Council 10287 Free throw Chairman) and Mrs. Amanda

Hawley (St Joseph's school principal) with Mr. Matthew Raya (athletic director at SJS) for enabling the participation of boys and girls at St Joseph school. At the state level our State Deputy Stephen Bolton initiated the first ever live streamed California "Novena for Life". At the national level the Knights initiated KnightCast, a professionally produced webcast series specifically designed to help Knights become better Catholics, better men, better husbands, and better fathers.

The first KnightCast addressed our change of Leadership at the Supreme Level. Patrick Kelly begins his tenure as the Order's 14th Supreme Knight as of March 1<sup>st</sup>. I invite all Council 10287 Knights to visit the kofc.org website for more information.

I am encouraged at the efforts to distribute proven vaccine and to vaccinate our brothers and sisters. I received a 1<sup>st</sup> Moderna vaccination Wednesday, with no ill effects. I am encouraged that several of our Council have received their second shot of vaccine. We are making progress as we begin to emerge from Covid restrictions. **Mass is being celebrated inside the church**, with limited capacity, face mask and social distancing restrictions. St Joseph's Knights considered the possibility of offering "drive thru" Lenten Fish and chips. Social distancing requirements and the space limitations of the parish hall kitchen precluded use of the kitchen. An alternative "fried rather than grilled" option was considered but rejected because the planning, preparation, and cost of such a venture would outweigh any potential profit.

Lent is also a time for alms giving. If you have not yet turned in your PSA pledge, now is the perfect time to do so. So many important Diocese programs such as Seminarian Education, Catholic Schools Tuition Assistance and Catholic Charities, just to name a few, rely on our donations. And as you know, all the money collected above our parish Diocese allocation is rebated back to St Joseph for needed Church upgrades as Father Miguel has explained at Mass. Let us Knights lead by example.

I am hopeful that we experience "in person" our rescheduled Mater Dolorosa annual retreat, now planned for 5-8 March 2021.

A final note – Catholic men joining our council pay NO fees/dues in THIS Columbian Year (ends 30 June 2021). Virtual exemplifications of Charity, Unity and Fraternity are available.




We had a wonderful response from our Brother Knights and their wives today with donations totaling Twenty-one blankets and three sleeping bags. They will come to good use for those homeless in need!
