## REFLECTIONS WITH FATHER MICHAEL: ALLOWING THE HOLY SPIRIT TO TAKE POSSESSION OF US

It was St. Paul who reminded us that no one can say, Jesus is the Lord, except by the power of the Holy Spirit. This implies that the Holy Spirit is very important in our lives as children of God, and followers of Christ Jesus. But, the big question is, do we truly give the Holy Spirit the chance to operate freely in our lives or do we attempt directly or indirectly to stifle or restrict the power?

As we noticed today in our first reading, when the Spirit of the Most High descended on the seventy elders of Israel some folks in Israel didn't like it, because in their jealousy they wanted to control the movement of the Holy Spirit. They wanted to dictate where the Spirit should go, and who should receive it. Isn't it sad?

My fellow reflectors and friends, how often do we see people who are jealous or envious of others' gifts and blessings? Wouldn't it be wonderful if we all had the same attitude that Moses showed today when he rejected the jealous complaint of Joshua by telling him, "Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets! Would that the Lord might bestow His spirit on them all!"

Wow! What a man of God! What a man who clearly understood that the Spirit of the Lord could not be confined to our narrow human prejudices. Moses, the great servant of God knew that God's spirit operated freely and took possession of whosoever opened themselves to the Spirit. We cannot purchase the power, and it is not conferred on people on account of their powerful human connections or influence. It is a free gift that comes to whoever is open to receive it.


Now let's pause a little bit here and ask ourselves whether we are truly open to the Holy Spirit in our daily endeavors. In other words, do we, for instance, begin our morning with prayer? And do we end our day with prayer also? More importantly, in the course of our daily prayer do we ask the Holy Spirit to take possession of us and use us for God's glory? The Holy Spirit will not come into us unless we are open to its presence. The truth we should not dispute is, we all need the Holy Spirit in our lives, because this powerful and uplifting force is capable of changing our lives for the better, no matter how deep we have sunk into sin or gone astray. The Spirit of the Most High can always transform us if we open our lives to its influence.

We can take this truth to the bank namely, apart from prayer, that another way of letting the Holy Spirit in our lives is to appreciate the gifts and blessings of others, rather than being jealous of them. Indeed, when we appreciate the gifts of others, and share our gifts and blessings with those around us, we open our lives wide to the vivifying power of the Holy Spirit. When this is done wonderful things begin to happen.

Sisters and brothers, try it and see for yourselves! May God bless us as we strive to do so.

Have a great and wonderful week, as we wish Happy Birthday to all who celebrated their birthdays this special month, including Fr. Michael who has now passed half a century and a dozen years! It is solely God's grace. To God be the glory!


