





# The Advent Symbols

Two of the best-known symbols of the Advent season are use of the liturgical colors (blueish/purple and pink) and the Advent Wreath. The primary liturgical color of Advent is a blueish/purple, the color of royalty. This symbolizes both the coming of the King of Israel at Christmas and the anticipated triumphant Second Coming of Christ. (Usage of blueish/violet has emerged recently to help avoid confusion with Lenten colors.) Pink, however, is used on the third Sunday of Advent, traditionally called Gaudete Sunday (from the Latin for rejoice). This rejoicing stems from passing the halfway point in Advent and from the readings of that week.


