

Schedule of Weekly Session Assignments from Home

*Please note: All lessons should be completed weekly. You will need to complete the activities for each session in your child's Student Textbook; all textbooks will be turned in the night of First Reconciliation. Please write your answers in the book.

In addition to completing the activities in the Student Textbook, all families should also complete the questions for each session listed below and turn them in on the due dates listed. These questions can be emailed or hand written on a separate sheet of paper and turned into the Religious Ed. Office when your child comes to class.

Students should also be able to recite the Sign of the Cross, Hail Mary, Lord's Prayer (Our Father), and Act of Contrition by heart prior to receiving their First Reconciliation in December. Please work with your child on learning those prayers each week.

Sunday, October 2nd – Session 1: God is Our Loving Father Completed

All families must complete the online lesson from Signs of Grace: You Are Forgiven.

In addition, please e-mail the Religious Ed Office at (<u>SacramentalPrep@Stchristopherski.org</u>) your child's answers (in their own words) to the following questions from Session 1:

- 1. What is Original Sin?
- 2. What does it mean to say that we have free will? What are some ways that you use your free will every day?

Sunday, October 9th – Session 2: God Reveals His Saving Plan Completed

All families must complete the online lesson from Signs of Grace: You Are Forgiven.

- 1. Why does God give us Laws?
- 2. God wants us to be happy in his family. What things do you do to help the people in your family to be happy?

Sunday, October 16th – Session 3: Jesus Comes to Save Us Completed

2. In the Parable of the Shepherd and the Lost Sheep, how do you think the shepherd felt when he realized that one of his sheep was missing? What does this story teach us about the love and mercy of Jesus?

Sunday, October 23rd – Session 4: The Church Continues Completed

- 1. What is a sacrament? Can you list the seven sacraments?
