1. #2- "Disobedience" which means refusal to obey rules or someone in authority.
2. #5- "weather" Meteorologists study weather.
3. #2- "Concise" which means saying a lot in few words. Verbose means using more words than necessary to convey a thought.
4. #1- "Disorganized" which means without order and messy.
5. #3 - "p" Kelly was always exhausted after her long cheerleading pactices.
6. #2- " MJCSD" Mike, Julie, Caden, Sheri, Donna
7. #3- "roots" Trees need roots to absorb water and nutrients from the soil and anchor the tree in the ground.

9. #b- "They are communicating on an internet forum."
10. #3 (-10 x 4) 20 -10= 10...10 x 4 = 40; 40 - 10 = 30... 30 x 4 = 120; 120 - 10 = 110...110 x 4 = 440; 440 - 1 = 430...430 x 4 = 1,720
11. #1- "Sincerity" which means honesty, truthfulness.
12. #3 "384" (+ 20 then ÷ 4) Add 20 to the first number in the row. Then you divide the second number by 4 to get the 3rd
First Row: 44 + 20 = 64...64 ÷ 4 = 16
Second Row: 28 + 20 = 48 ...48 ÷ 4 = 12
Third Row: work it backwards 101 x 4 = 404...404 - 20 = 384
13. #3- "Felony" which is a classification for a serious crime.
14. #3- "67" (+ .5 x 2) 7.5 + .5 = 8... 8 x 2 = 16; 16 + .5 = 16.5 x 2 = 33 ; 33 + .5 = 33.5 ...33.5 x 2 = 67
15. #2 "brain" Podiatrists treat conditions of the feet. Neurologists treat conditions of the brain.
16. #3 "3" - The number on top multiplied by itself then multiplied by 3.
First column: 3 x 3 = 9...9 x 3 = 27
Second column: 5 x 5 = 25...25 x 3 = 75
Third column: 8 x 8 = 64...64 x 3 = 192
Fourth column 1 x 1 = 1...1 x 3 = 3
17. #2- "Deliberate" which means done consciously and intentionally.
18. #1- "repulsive (intensely disgusting) - inedible (not suitable for eating)"
19. #1- "Defeatist" which is a person who expects or is ready to accept failure.
20. #1- "Apathetic" which means feeling no interest, enthusiasm or concern-indifferent.
21. #1- "t" Chad was recognized as the most dedicated player in the soccer tournament.
22. #2- "328" 8528 pages ÷ 26 books = 328 pages per book
23. #1- "losers" is the best fit for this analogy
24. #5- "Insignificant" which means too small or unimportant to be worth consideration. Something that is insignificant would be considered unimportant.

25. #3- "\$13.65" Supplies: $\$10.32 + \$7.65 + \$4.89 + \$3.99 = \$26.85$ Sales: $\$0.75 \times 54 = \$40.50 \dots \$40.50 - \$26.85 = \mathbf{\$13.65 \text{ profit}}$
26. #3- "\$6.83" $\$13.65 \div 2 = \$6.825 \dots \$6.83$ is a little more than half of \$13.65
27. #2- "Fake" which means not genuine.
28. #1- "27" (down each column $\times \frac{1}{2} + 18$)
 First column: $6 \times .5 = 3 \dots 3 + 18 = \mathbf{21}$
 Second column: $10 \times .5 = 5 \dots 5 + 18 = \mathbf{23}$
 Third column: $18 \times .5 = 9 \dots 9 + 18 = \mathbf{27}$
29. #4- "M" Michael chose to express his political viewpoint through his artwork.
30. #3- "fire" There can be no smoke without fire.
31. #3- "workstation" All of the words are types of workstations.
32. #3- "Mischeivous" is misspelled.
33. #4- "drama" A Monologue is a long speech given by one actor. A solo is a piece of music played or sang by a single musician.
34. #2- "261" ($+ 6 \times 3$) $1 + 6 = 7 \dots 7 \times 3 = \mathbf{21}$; $21 + 6 = 27 \dots 27 \times 3 = \mathbf{81}$;
 $81 + 6 = 87 \dots 87 \times 3 = \mathbf{261}$

36. #2- "book" A portrait is a type of picture and a biography is a type of book.
37. #1 - "1215" $1,800 \times .75 = 1,350 \dots 1,350 \times .9 = \mathbf{1,215}$ Facebook friends
